ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND
DIRECTING PARTIES TO CONFER ON
BRIEFING SCHEDULE

On September 8, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and-Desist Proceedings (OIP) against Respondent Joseph J. Fox, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A hearing is currently scheduled for October 19, 2015.

Based on tracking information provided by the Office of the Secretary, the OIP was sent by U.S. Postal Service certified mail to Fox's residence in Los Angeles, California, but has not yet reached California. It therefore does not appear that service has been accomplished in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(i), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i).

It is ORDERED that the hearing currently scheduled for October 19, 2015, is postponed *sine die*. The Division of Enforcement is directed to file, by October 30, 2015, a declaration regarding the status of service including, if applicable, any evidence that service has been accomplished.

Based upon my review of the OIP, it seems reasonably possible to resolve this proceeding through motions for summary disposition. Accordingly, it is FURTHER ORDERED that the parties confer regarding a briefing schedule for motions for summary disposition and file a report proposing such a schedule by October 30, 2015. If, after reviewing the motions for summary disposition, I determine that a hearing is necessary, additional proceedings will be scheduled.
