ORDER FOLLOWING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE
AND TO SHOW CAUSE

On October 30, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. Respondents were served with the OIP, and their Answers were due by November 17, 2015. *American Power Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3300, 2015 SEC LEXIS 4597 (Nov. 6, 2015). I previously notified the parties that a telephonic prehearing conference would be held on November 30. *American Power Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3301, 2015 SEC LEXIS 4601 (Nov. 6, 2015).

At the November 30 prehearing conference, counsel for the Division of Enforcement appeared, but Respondents did not. To date, Respondents have not filed Answers.

Accordingly, I ORDER Respondents to SHOW CAUSE by December 11, 2015, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file Answers, appear at the scheduled prehearing conference of which they were notified, or otherwise defend this proceeding. Any Respondent that fails to respond to this Order will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registrations of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f), .221(f).
