Today, Brian J. Ourand submitted a motion to stay the proceeding pending the outcome of a related criminal proceeding, stating that he was indicted in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia on December 3, 2015. Ourand's motion will be denied. The Commission's rules do not authorize the undersigned to grant such a stay at the request of a party. <sup>1</sup>
