ORDER POSTPONING HEARING AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On December 16, 2015, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service establishing that service of the OIP was accomplished on December 15, 2015, in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). As such, Respondent's Answer is due by December 28, 2015. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for December 29, 2015, and schedule a telephonic prehearing conference for 2:00 p.m. EST on that date. Respondent is on notice that if it fails to file a timely Answer, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, I will deem it in default, determine that the allegations in the OIP are true, and revoke the registration of its securities.
