SCHEDULING ORDER

On October 14, 2016, the parties filed a joint status report regarding proposed prehearing dates. I ADOPT the schedule with some modifications as follows:

November 14, 2016:	Parties shall file amended witness lists and exchange, but not file, premarked copies of exhibits and amended exhibit lists.
November 21, 2016:	Parties shall file any motions in limine and objections to new exhibits and witnesses. <sup>1</sup>
December 5, 2016:	Parties shall file any requests for official notice, stipulations, admissions of fact, and stipulations concerning the contents, authenticity, or admissibility into evidence of documents.
December 7, 2016:	Parties shall participate in a telephonic prehearing conference, if necessary, at a time to be determined.
December 12, 2016:	Hearing commences in Atlanta, Georgia, at a location to be determined.
