The exhibit list should specify the exhibit number, description of the exhibit, Bates-stamp numbers, if any, and page(s) in the hearing transcript in which the exhibit was offered and admitted.
- 3. The Division and Respondent are responsible for filing their respective hearing exhibits in hardcopy form with the Office of the Secretary by July 7, 2017.
