Order Directing the Parties to Hold a Prehearing Conference and Gamzio Mobile, Inc., to Show Cause

Respondents' answers to the Securities and Exchange Commission's order instituting proceedings (OIP) were due by September 27, 2017. *Gamzio Mobile, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5072, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2925 (ALJ Sept. 20, 2017). Gold Hill Resources, Inc., filed an answer, but Gamzio Mobile, Inc., has not.

I ORDER the parties to hold an initial prehearing conference without the hearing officer by October 12, 2017, to discuss each numbered item in Rule 221(c), 17 C.F.R. § 201.221(c). By October 16, 2017, the parties shall file a joint prehearing conference statement addressing the numbered items in Rule 221(c) and proposing due dates when applicable. The parties may denote an item "not applicable" in the prehearing conference statement.

I FURTHER ORDER Gamzio Mobile to SHOW CAUSE by October 12, 2017, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failures to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Gamzio Mobile fails to respond to this order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
