**Order Ratifying Actions** 

On November 30, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission ratified the appointments of its administrative law judges. *See Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724, at 1. For pending cases in which no initial decision has been issued, the Commission directed that I take certain actions in cases assigned to me, including granting the parties "until January 5, 2018 to submit any new evidence the parties deem relevant to [my] reexamination of the record." *Id.* at \*2. For good cause, I may modify the deadlines in the Commission's order. <sup>1</sup> *Id.* at \*3–4.

The Division of Enforcement is currently attempting to serve the Respondent in this case. The Division's update on the status of efforts to serve Respondent is due January 16, 2018, and every three months thereafter. *ANV Sec. Grp., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5181, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3307 (ALJ Oct. 17, 2017). Respondent has not filed an answer and no evidence has been presented.

Considering the foregoing, I ratify all actions I have taken and orders I have issued in this case. See Wilkes-Barre Hosp. Co. v. NLRB, 857 F.3d 364,
