The Registrant is a wholly-owned subsidiary of CME Group. An organizational chart for CME Group, including the Registrant, is attached as <u>Exhibit C-1</u>. As the chart indicates, CME Group, a public company owned by public shareholders and listed for trading on the NASDAQ Stock Market, currently has a number of direct wholly-owned subsidiaries, including CME, as well as a variety of indirect subsidiaries. CME, a CFTC-registered entity, houses the registered futures exchange as well as operates its derivatives clearing organization.

A chart depicting the internal organizational structure of the Registrant with regard to its clearing agency activities is attached as <u>Exhibit C-2</u>. In addition to their reporting relationships within the Registrant's organizational structure, the Registrant officers depicted in the chart, as well as any other employees of CME Group businesses assigned to work on the Registrant's clearing agency activities, may have reporting relationships to other CME Group businesses. Those reporting relationships will correspond to the departments with which the officers' or employees' duties are associated.
