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IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that defendant Betty Ann Rubin shall be liable for disgorgement of her ill-gotten gains in the amount of \$309,040.40, together with prejudgment interest, calculated pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961, in the amount of \$37,370.52, totalling \$346,410.92.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Lazar Frederick & Company shall pay the \$7,935,990.32 disgorgement and prejudgment interest amount by cashier's check, certified check, or postal money order forthwith. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that, except as modified by this Judgment or other order of the Court, the Order of Preliminary Injunction and Orders: (1) Freezing Assets; (2) Prohibiting Transfer of Assets; and (3) Appointing a Permanent Receiver ("Preliminary Injunction"), issued April 4, 1996 shall continue in full force and effect.

VI. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for all purposes in connection with this matter, including implementation and enforcement of the terms of this Judgment and other decrees that may be entered herein and to grant such other relief as the Court may deem necessary and just. There being no just reason for delay, the Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to enter this Final Judgment forthwith.
