JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT TODD JOSEPH LASCOLA

Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's motion for summary judgment is GRANTED.

Judgment may enter in favor of the Securities and Exchange Commission against Todd Joseph LaScola as follows:

- 1. Permanently restraining and enjoining LaScola, CPI Investment Management and CPA Advisors, their officers, agents, servants and attorneys, and those persons in active concert with them who receive actual notice of the final judgment, from further violations of section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, 17 C.F.R. 240.10b-5, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, 15 U.S.C. § 77q(a), and Sections 206(1) and 206(2) of the Investment Advisors Act of 1940, 15 U.S.C.§§ 80b-6(1) and 80b-6(2);
- 2. Directing LaScola to disgorge all gains and benefits they received unlawfully as a result of the conduct complained of in the amount of \$6,329,825,70, plus prejudgment interest; and
- 3. Directing LaScola to pay civil penalties in the amount
