THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S NOTICE REGARDING CITATIONS TO THE HEARING TRANSCRIPT IN ITS POST-HEARING BRIEF AND PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Division of Enforcement (the "Division") filed its Post-Hearing Brief and Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in this matter on November 24, 2014.

After the filing of these materials, counsel for the Division obtained copies of an "Amended" transcript of the October 20-22, 2014 evidentiary hearing in this matter, which purports to correct a number of typographical and transcription errors in the original transcript. Because of the timing of counsel's receipt of the amended transcript, the Division's Post-Hearing Brief and Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law cite to the *original* hearing transcript, rather than the amended one.

The Division provides notice that its Reply Brief, due on December 15, 2014, will reference only the *amended* version of the hearing transcript, not the original one. At the Court's direction, the Division will also prepare an Amended Post-Hearing Brief and/or an Amended Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, wherein the record citations have been changed to reference the amended hearing transcript.
