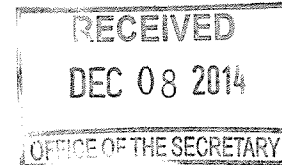

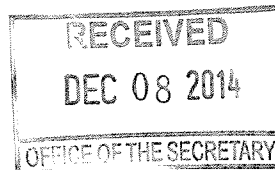

Dear Judge Grimes:

By Order dated August 20, 2014, Your Honor granted a stay of proceedings in the above-referenced matter in light of the pending criminal case involving substantially the same facts. The undersigned, who are the Assistant U.S. Attorneys assigned to the criminal matter, respectfully request that the stay be continued pending resolution of the criminal case. Yesterday, the Honorable Colleen McMahon, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York, set a motion schedule in the criminal matter (*United States v. Moore*, 14 Cr. 648 (CM)) that will culminate in oral argument on March 4, 2015 at 12:30 p.m. It is expected that, at that time, the Court will set a trial date, unless a disposition is reached beforehand. Given that the criminal case is still very much active, we submit that the public interest continues to support a stay of the civil proceedings.
