The Division of Enforcement (the "Division") respectfully submits this Status Report pursuant to the Commission's Order Directing Status Report from the Division of Enforcement. *See Sean Andrew O'Neal*, Securities Exchange Act Rel. No. 100190 (May 21, 2024). On June 26, 2023, the Order Instituting Proceedings ("OIP") was personally served on Sean Andrew O'Neal ("O'Neal"). O'Neal did not file an answer within the required 20 days of service and the Commission ordered him to show cause by December 21, 2023 why he should not be in default. In April 2024, O'Neal transmitted an executed Offer of Settlement to the Division. However, that offer did not include one of the standard terms the Division now requires. Accordingly, O'Neal has been asked to execute a revised offer. The Division will further update the Commission regarding the status of this matter within 30 days of this status report.
