1. We wish you the endless development of your committee.

2,We have received investment in kind from building and development business owners in China, registered as a corporation in Wyoming, USA, and registered shares (ticker name: ATCC) with the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC).

3. After asking an international lawyer, we received a reply saying that "if you want to invest in kind from China to the United States, you can only make in-kind investments in the U.S. after obtaining approval (authorization) from the General Administration of Commerce, Industry and Energy, the jurisdiction of China with appraisal document of real estate in kind and the consent of the owners to transfer ownership and In-kind investment contract."

4.Our company has been in the midst of his illness and the late CEO Lee Sung-yeol's

all data of ATCC was stored in the United States.

So there was no data on the company in Korea.

As a result of investigating and confirming the employees who worked in the liaison office in Korea, we secured in-kind investment contracts and appraisal reports for 33 in-kind investment properties in China.

5. Your Committee is in the process of revoking the registration of ATCC shares due to false or exaggerated property in kind worth \$71 billion.

6. Therefore, we have signed a contract with a law firm in Beijing, China to confirm the real estate in kind, and as soon as the real estate investment is confirmed, we will submit it to your committee after receiving a confirmation of the investment in kind and notarization from the law firm in China.

7. Please extend the administrative procedure of ATCC stock deregistration until the company confirms the property invested in kind and submits a confirmation to your committee.
