DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S STATUS REPORT REGARDING SERVICE OF ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDING

Pursuant to the Commission's Order Regarding Service, dated November 22, 2023, the Division retained a process server and attempt to serve the Respondents by personal service as provided in Rule 141(a)(2)(i) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

The Division was able to serve Respondent Brian Amoah at his residence on December 9, 2023. (*See* attached Return of Service) Counsel for the Division also has emailed Amoah, and left him a voicemail message, requesting an opportunity to discuss this matter. But Amoah has not responded.

The Division attempted to serve Respondent Elbert Elliott at his last known residence but learned that he has been evicted and left no information regarding his whereabouts. The Division will continue its attempts to locate and serve Elliott with the OIP. If those efforts are not successful, the Division will file another status report regarding service on or before February 14, 2024.


