ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

On September 19, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings (“OIP”) against Travis A. Branch pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940.¹ Counsel for the Division of Enforcement filed a notice of appearance on October 5, 2018, but no other filings have been made in this proceeding, including as to whether the OIP was served upon Branch. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by May 24, 2019, and every 28 days thereafter until service is accomplished.
