ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

On June 3, 2022, Jeffrey Stuart Gerson, an associated person of a FINRA member firm, filed an application for review of a FINRA action. Gerson had submitted a claim for arbitration with FINRA Dispute Resolution Services requesting expungement of certain customer dispute information from the Central Registration Depository. FINRA notified Gerson that his claim was not eligible for arbitration, and he appealed.

On June 17, 2022, Gerson filed an unopposed motion to withdraw his application for review. Under the circumstances, it is appropriate to grant Gerson's unopposed request.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Jeffrey Stuart Gerson to withdraw his application for review is granted and that this review proceeding is dismissed.
