## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

The Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings on September 12, 2023, under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, against Ameri Metro, Inc. ("Respondent").<sup>1</sup> On November 21, 2024, the Division of Enforcement moved for summary disposition. Pursuant to the Commission's scheduling order, Respondent had until December 23, 2024, to respond to the Division's motion.<sup>2</sup> Respondent now files an unopposed motion for a 21-day extension of time in which to file its brief.<sup>3</sup> Under the circumstances, it appears appropriate to grant Respondent's request for good cause shown.<sup>4</sup>

In its motion, Respondent states that it requests a 21-day extension to January 15, 2025 pursuant to Rule of Practice 161(c)(1). See 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(1) ("[E]xtensions of time for filing papers shall not exceed 21 days unless the Commission . . . sets forth in a written order the reasons why a longer period of time is necessary."). But 21 days from December 23, 2024, is actually January 13, 2025.

See Rule of Practice 161, 17 C.F.R. § 201.161; see also Pending Administrative Proceedings, Exchange Act Release No. 88415, 2020 WL 1322001, at \*1 (Mar. 18, 2020) (stating that "pending further order of the Commission, all reasonable requests for extensions of time will not be disfavored as stated in Rule 161" (citing 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(b)(1))).

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that Respondent shall file its response to the Division's motion by January 13, 2025; and the Division shall file any reply in support of its motion by February 12, 2025.
