TO DEFENDANTS AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") hereby files a motion for an order to show cause why Defendant Robert W. Wilson should not be held in civil contempt for failure to comply with the Court's "Final Judgment" (Doc. # 51). This motion seeks relief pursuant to the Court's "inherent power to enforce compliance with [its] lawful orders through civil contempt," *Shillitani v. United States*, 384 U.S. 364, 370 (1966), and the provision in the Final Judgment in which the Court expressly retained jurisdiction of this matter for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Final Judgment. Final Judgment § VIII.

The motion seeks an order of civil contempt for Wilson's failure to comply with two provisions of the Final Judgment: (1) an injunction that prohibits him from offering and selling securities (Final Judgment § IV (the "Securities Injunction")); and (2) an order to disgorge \$1,540,000, plus prejudgment interest in the amount of \$205,376.25 (Final Judgment § V (the "Disgorgement Order")). Wilson violated the Securities Injunction by offering securities to unsophisticated investors and the general public in a gold milling venture. Wilson violated the Disgorgement Order by failing to pay any of the amount ordered to be disgorged.

This motion will be heard at 10:30 a.m. on June 22, 2020, in the Courtroom of the Hon. M. James Lorenz, United States District Judge, at the U.S. Courthouse for the Southern District of California, located at 221 West Broadway, San Diego, California. Pursuant to Local Rule, there will be no appearances unless requested by the Court.

The SEC's motion is supported by the accompanying SEC's Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of its Motion for an Order to Show Cause why Defendant Robert W. Wilson Should not be Held in Civil Contempt, the declarations of Terry R. Miller, Michael J. Roessner, and Connie Page, exhibits attached thereto, the Court's record in this case, any additional briefing the Court requests or the Rules of the Court allow, and any evidence and argument that will be presented to the Court
