JUDGMENT

Upon consent (**Docket # 17**), the Court issued an order on August 14, 1999, waiving payment of disgorgement and prejudgment interest and not imposing a civil money penalty as to defendant Hernán José Pérez. (**Docket # 19**). Furthermore, on August 31, 1999, the Court dismissed this action with prejudice as to defendant Víctor Mestres Ayendez, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2). (**Docket # 20**).

It is also hereby **FURTHER ORDERED** that upon entry of this judgment, this action be **STRICKEN FROM THE ACTIVE DOCKET**. Judgment is hereby entered accordingly.
