COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

SEC COMMENTS ON NYSE INCORPORATION. The SEC yesterday announced that it had responded to the New York Stock Exchange regarding the February 18, 1971, incorporation of the Exchange. While it indicated that there may not be an inevitable conflict between incorporation and the duties of the Exchange under the Securities Exchange Act, the Commission requested that an adequate presentation on this issue be made by the Exchange. In particular, the Commission invited consideration of whether there may be a conflict between, on the one hand, limiting members' liability for non-compliance by the Exchange with its duties under the Act and, on the other hand, the carrying out by the Exchange of its responsibilities to be an effective self-regulatory organization.

The Commission also raised several questions regarding a related proposed New York Stock Exchange rule which in certain circumstances would require certain member firms to reimburse the Exchange for payments by it arising out of its alleged failure to prevent or to require action by a member.

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTION

ALLEN MARTIN ENJOINED. The SEC Denver Regional Office today announced that the Federal court in Denver on March 10 permanently enjoined by default, Allen C. Martin, also known as Allen C. Kaye-Martin of Miami, Fla., from violating the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws in the offer and sale of securities of J B & T Company, and S & M Industries, Inc. (LR-4939)

SHELBY SECURITIES, AXELROD ENJOINED. The SEC New York Regional Office today announced that on March 11, the Federal court in New York permanently enjoined Shelby Securities, Inc., New York registered broker-dealer, and Marry Axelrod, secretary-treasurer, from violating the net capital and anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws. The defendants consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (LR-4940)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

BOSTON CAPITAL RECEIVES ORDER. The SEC has issued an exemption order under the Investment Company Act permetting the proposed participation by Boston Capital Corporation, Boston closed-end, non-diversified management investment company, and Sea World, Inc. in a public offering of shares of Sea World, Inc. (of whose outstanding voting shares, Boston Capital owns 19%). In a proposed public offering of 400,000 common shares of Sea World, 230,488 are to be offered by Sea World and 169,512 (outstanding shares) by Boston Capital. (Release 10-6387)

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

FORT HOWARD PAPER FILES FOR SECONDARY. Fort Howard Paper Company, 1919 S. Broadway, <u>Green Bay, Wisc.</u> 54305, filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seeking registration of 432,000 outstanding shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale by the holders thereof. The offering is to be made through underwriters headed by Goldman, Sachs & Co., 55 Broad St., New York.

The company is engaged in the manufacture and distribution of disposable paper products. It has outstanding 6,595,800 common shares. John P. Cofrin is president. Fort Howard Paper Foundation, Inc. proposes to sell all of 362,400 shares held and eight others the remaining shares being registered. (File 2-39646)

NORTHERN INDIANA FUBLIC SERVICE TO SELL FINDS. Northern Indiana Public Service Company, 5265 Hohman Ave., Hammond, Ind. 46320, filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seeking registration of \$50,000,000 of first mortgage bonds, Series S, to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding. A public utility, the company will apply the net proceeds of its bond sale to the cost of construction, including prepayment of bank loans made for that purpose (expected to aggregate \$10 million at completion of the bond sale). Construction expenditures are estimated at \$62,300,000 in 1971 and \$134,600,000 in 1972. (File 2-39647)

*ACETO CHEMICAL PROPOSES OFFERING. Aceto Chemical Co., Inc., 126-02 Northern Slvd., Flushing, N. Y. 11368, filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seeking registration of \$1,500,000 or subordinated sinking fund debentures, due 1985, with warrants to purchase 75,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale in units, each consisting of a \$1,000 debenture and warrants to purchase 50 shares, and at \$1,005 per unit. The offering is to be made through underwriters headed by S. D. Fuller & Co. Inc., 26 Broadway, New York 10004. Of the net proceeds of its debenture sale, \$600,000 will be used for expansion of production and marketing of the company's product line, and the balance for working capital and general corporate purposes. *WASHINGTON WATER POWER PROPOSES OFFERING. The Washington Water Power Company, East 1411 Mission Ave., Spokane, wash. 99202, filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seeking registration of \$15,000,000 of sinking fund debentures, due 1991, and 250,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Kidder, Pesbody & Co., Inc., 20 Exchange Pl., New York 10005. Of the net proceeds of its financing, \$12,000,000 will be used to prepay unsecured promissory notes, due 1972 (\$14,000,000 of such notes presently outstanding) and the balance for construction purposes. Construction expenditures are estimated at \$21,680,000 for 1971. (File 2-39651)

ALUMET TO SELL STOCK. The Alumet Corporation, 180 Miller Pl., <u>Hicksville</u>, N. Y., filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seeking registration of 241,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale through underwriters headed by Agio Capital Corporation, Two Broadway, New York 10004. (**\$6 per share maximum)

The company was organized in January to acquire the assets and assume the liabilities of a wholly-owned subsidiary of Templet Industries, Incorporated relating to the mechanochemical sheet metal blanking system for the production of precision metal stampings, and is undertaking the development and manufacture of the process and the marketing of products produced thereby. Of the net proceeds of its stock sale, \$225,000 will be used to purchase production equipment, and the balance will be added to the company's working capital and used for general corporate purposes. The company has outstending 510,000 common shares (with a 16¢ per share net tangible book value), of which Templet Industries owns 90.2%. Lawrence M. Rheingold is bard chairman and Louis De Lalio is president. (Pile 2-39652)

MICHIGAN WISCONSIN PIPE LINE TO SELL BONDS. Michigan Wisconsin Pipe Line Company, One Woodward Ave., Detroit, Mach. 43226, filed a registration statement with the SEC on March 16 seaking registration of \$40 million of first mortgage pipe line bonds, due 1991, to be offered for public sale at competitive bidding. A subsidiary of American Natural Gas Company, the company will use the net proceeds of its bond sale, together with proceeds of the sale of \$20 million of common stock to the parent, to retire \$40 million of borrowings estimated to be outstanding at the time of the bond sale, and the balance will be applied toward 1971 construction requirements and advance payments related to gas purchases. Construction expenditures and advances for gas purchase are estimated at \$55 million each for 1971. (File 2-39653)
