COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

LIBRARY

JAMES ELDON WREN, OTHERS PLEAD GUILTY

The Denver Regional Office announced that on January 20 before the Honorable Ewing T. Kerr, District Court Judge for the District of Wyoming, after one day of trial, James Eldon Wren pled guilty to one count of securities fraud and one count of mail fraud, Edward Brooks Pollack pled guilty to one count of securities fraud and one count of the sale of unregistered securities, Garvin Taylor pled guilty to one count of the sale of unregistered securities, and Chester Roy Evans pled guilty to one count of the sale of securities in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. All of the above counts charged violations in connection with the offer and sale of the securities of Oil Additives, Inc. (OAI). (U.S. v. Wren, et al., U.S.D.C., Wyoming, Criminal No. 75-71). HARRY J. BINDER AND ARTHUR H. PIPER ENJOINED

The Washington Regional Office announced that on February 9 the federal court in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania entered orders of permanent injunction enjoining Harry J. Binder of Jenkintown, Pennsylvania and Arthur H. Piper of Glenside, Pennsylvania from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Binder, formerly a member of the Philadelphia-Baltimore-Washington Stock Exchange, and Piper consented to the order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Harry J. Binder and Arthur H. Piper, E.D. Pa., Civil Action No. 76-127). (LR-7283)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INTERNATIONAL HOLDINGS CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15 to request a hearing on an application of International Holdings Corporation for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-9165 - Feb. 18)

THOMAS E. CONNETT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15 to request a hearing on an application of Thomas E. Connett, a self-employed management consultant, and Midland Capital Corporation, a registered closed-end, non-diversified, management investment company, for an order of the Commission permitting Connett to receive shares of Lemmon Pharmacal Company in connection with Midland's purchase of shares of that company at a time when Connett was an affiliated person of an affiliated person of Midland. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM

An order has been issued approving a proposal of Columbia and its subsidiary companies to specially allocate consolidated return tax liabilities among system companies in a manner other than prescribed in Rule 45(b)(6) for taxable year 1975 and retaining jurisdiction over Columbia's request to allocate tax liability in the same manner for taxable year 1976. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing certain changes in terms of guarantees of loans made by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, and Delmarva Power & Light Company, to an unaffiliated coal supplier. (Rel. 35-19394 - Feb. 19)

The SEC has announced the suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Canadian Javelin Ltd. for the further ten-day period February 23 - March 3, inclusive.

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the applications of the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. to strike from listing and registration the common stock of Callon Petroleum Company and INA Investment Securities, Inc. The applications were made at the request of the two companies. The common stock of INA remains listed and registered on the New York, PBW and Detroit Stock Exchanges.

An order has also been issued granting the application of the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. to strike from listing and registration the common stock of American Chain & Cable Company, Inc. The company has less than 193,000 shares in public hands as a result of a tender offer made by Babcock International, Inc. (Rel. 34-12122)
