## DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### NASD ACTION AGAINST HAROLD R. FENOCCHIO AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed the NASD's suspension of Harold R. Fenocchio, of West Sacramento, California, from association with any NASD member for 15 days, and the Association's imposition of a \$2,500 fine. Fenocchio was a salesman for the former Sacramento broker-dealer firm of Jack Mingo & Company, Inc.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that Fenocchio induced excessive trading by customers in mutual fund shares and real estate securities in order to generate commissions; failed to have customers execute a letter of intent or to inform them of their rights of accumulation in connection with mutual fund purchases, with the result that customers did not receive the reduced sales charge to which they were entitled; and was responsible for a customer making unsuitable investments in light of his financial needs and objectives. ### BANQUE de PARIS et des PAYS-BAS (SUISSE) CENSURED

The Commission has censured Banque de Paris et des Pays-Bas (Suisse) S.A. (BDP) and imposed certain procedures, to be instituted by BDP, to ensure its compliance with United States securities laws in instances where BDP or accounts of BDP acquire, during the initial distribution period, securities registered with the Commission.

The sanctions were based on findings that BDP violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the securities of Pelorex Corp. The Commission's action was taken pursuant to the offer of settlement of BDP, in which the respondent, without admitting or denying the charges against it, consented to the above findings and sanctions. BDP, in its offer of settlement, noted that its transactions in the registered common stock of Pelorex Corp. giving rise to the institution of the proceeding, were executed on behalf of a customer. ### INTERNATIONAL INVESTORS INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 14 to request a hearing on an application by International Investors, Incorporated (International), an open-end investment company, and I.I.I. Securities Corporation, International's principal underwriter, for an order permitting an offer of exchange of shares of Standard & Poor's/InterCapital Liquid Asset Fund, Inc. (S&P) for shares of International upon payment of a \$5 exchange fee but without the customary sales charge described in International's prospectus.
