## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### ORGANIC BIO-CONVERSIONS, INC. AND JACK D. DINGMAN ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on September 5 Judge Charles M. Allen, U.S. District Court for the Western District of Kentucky, entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Organic Bio-Conversions, Inc., Madisonville, Kentucky, and Jack D. Dingman, president of Organic Bio. The Judgment enjoins the defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleged that Organic Bio and Dingman fraudulently sold over \$3 million of unregistered common stock and convertible notes from January 1982 to February 1984 to more than 700 investors who were residents of 15 states, Canada and the Virgin Islands. Organic Bio and Dingman consented to the Judgments without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Organic Bio-Conversions, Inc. and Jack D. Dingman, W.D. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Boston Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-BSE-84-5) to amend Chapter 1B, Section 3 of the rules of the BSE which currently restricts non-member access to the floor of the BSE to permit the entering of orders from the trading floor of foreign exchange approved by the BSE to the Board of Governors. The BSE is also proposing to establish an electronic linkage with the floor of the Montreal Stock Exchange whereby Montreal will direct market orders in U.S.-listed Canadian national stocks traded in the Intermarket Trading System to the floor of the BSE through electronic terminals located on the Montreal floor. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
