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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### AMENDMENTS TO FORM ADV ADOPTED

The Commission adopted amendments to Form ADV, the investment adviser registration form, and related rule amendments under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The revisions to Form ADV were developed jointly by the Commission and the North American Securities Administrators Association, Inc. to make the form a uniform form for advisers to register with the Commission and the states. The revised form will be effective on January 1, 1986 for new registrants filing with the Commission; existing registrants will be required to amend their registrations by filing the new form by March 31, 1986. ### AMENDMENT TO RULE 22c-1 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted an amendment to Rule 22c-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940 that will permit an insurance company separate account to price an initial purchase payment for a variable annuity contract in accordance with a two-day/five-day procedure. (Rel. IC-14756)

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST THOMAS J. FITTIN, JR.

The Commission issued an Order for Public Proceedings and Notice of Hearing (Order) under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Thomas J. Fittin, Jr. From at least September 15, 1981 through May 15, 1982, Fittin was the president and principal shareholder in Fittin, Cunningham & Lauzon (FCL), a registered broker-dealer. He is currently a registered representative with another registered broker-dealer. According to the Order, the Division of Enforcement alleges that Fittin participated in communications concerning oil and gas drilling operations in Texas with investors from at least September 15, 1981 through May 15, 1982 during the offerings and sales of interests in at least three limited partnership drilling programs through FCL. The Division alleges that Fittin wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and the Securities Act of 1933, through these communications. A hearing will be held to determine whether the allegations against Fittin are true and to determine whether any remedial relief is appropriate. (Rel. 34-22482)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST SECURITIES TRANSFER, INC., OTHERS

The Commission today announced that Judge G. Kendall Sharp entered preliminary injunctions against Securities Transfer, Inc. (STI), Express Transfers, Inc. (ETI), Sharon Alfonso and Vernon Hulme in a previously filed Commission action. The orders preliminarily enjoin Hulme, Alfonso and STI from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and STI, ETI and Alfonso from further violations of the transfer agent provisions. The orders provide for a temporary freeze of Hulme's and Alfonso's assets in the amount of \$950,000 and \$29,000, respectively. Judge Sharp ordered the appointment of special compliance counsel for STI and ETI to insure that they are operated in accordance with the securities laws. STI, ETI, Alfonso and Hulme consented to the orders without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The Commission's request for a preliminary injunction against Joseph Bumyea and for permanent injunctions against all defendants remains pending. The complaint charges that Hulme, Bumyea, and Alfonso engaged in a fraudulent scheme whereby stock certificates, which had not been validly issued and were given by Bumyea to Hulme for use in borrowing funds, and that Hulme shared the proceeds from these transactions with Bumyea, Alfonso and STI. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### VARIABLE INSURANCE PRODUCTS FUND

An order has been issued exempting Variable Insurance Products Fund, certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit mixed and shared funding.
