CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

HEARING TO DISTRIBUTE MARTIN DISGORGEMENT TO BE HELD

The Commission announced today that Judge John C. Coughenour of the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington issued an Order on April 16 setting procedures for the distribution of funds disgorged by Gary L. Martin, et al. The Order sets a hearing for June 27, 1986, at which time the Court will direct the disbursement of the funds. As of May 31, 1985, the funds subject to disgorgement totalled \$416,827.67. [See LR-10151, October 3, 1983, and LR-9642, April 7, 1982].

All investors who sold Santa Fe call options to Martin in August and September 1981 and other interested persons can file a claim with the Clerk of the U.S. District Court, 1010 Fifth Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, no later than May 16, 1986. Objections to other claims must be filed no later than May 30, 1986. Claim information can be obtained from the Receiver's counsel, Michael D. ARMSTRONG GROUP CHARGED WITH INVESTMENT ADVISER AND BROKER-DEALER VIOLATIONS

The Atlanta Regional Office filed an action on April 8 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia to enjoin Armstrong Group, Inc. (AGI) from further violations, and Colony Asset Corporation, Kenneth S. Armstrong, and Donald P. Clark, all of Atlanta, Georgia, from aiding and abetting violations of the registration provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 in connection with investment advisory activities rendered by the defendants.

The complaint alleges that the defendants, while not registered under the Act, provided investment advice through group and individual advisory sessions to over 2,500 purchasers of a financial planning package called the Master Plan. The complaint also alleges that Colony, aided and abetted by Armstrong and Clark, violated the broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by engaging in the business of effecting transactions in and induced the purchase and sale of securities, including limited partnerships and investment contracts, while not registered as a broker or dealer. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

STATE MUTUAL SECURITIES, INC.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSRB-86-7) stating that dealers must disclose to customers any uncertainty of whether interest paid on certain municipal securities issues would be deemed subject to federal income taxation.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 14. (Rel. 34-23122)

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSOLIDATED QUOTATION PLAN AND CONSOLIDATED TAPE ASSOCIATION PLAN

Participants of the Consolidated Quotation Plan (CQ Plan) and Consolidated Tape Association (CTA) have submitted amendments adopting a new, consolidated form for use by professional subscribers to Network B of the CQ and CTA Plans. (Rel. 34-23123)

WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia and Philadelphia Depository Trust Company have requested that proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 be withdrawn. The proposals (SR-SCCP-86-1 and SR-Philadelp-86-2) penalized participants for failing to confirm promptly the accuracy of monthly account statements. Accordingly, the Commission has withdrawn the proposed rule changes. (Rel. 34-23124)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

R.J. REYNOLDS INDUSTRIES, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by R.J. Reynolds Industries, Inc. that the trusteeships of Chemical Bank under four indentures dated June 1, 1968, April 1, 1971, May 1, 1971 and December 15, 1974 and qualified under the Act are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Chemical Bank from acting as trustee under the indentures.
