RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

REPORTING BY SMALL ISSUERS

The Commission adopted revisions of Rules 12g-1, 12g-4 and 12h-3 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 so that issuers with less than 500 securityholders of record and \$5 million in total assets need not be subject to the registration and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. The revisions are effective on August 15, 1986. (Rel. 34-23406)

In a companion action, the Commission is soliciting comments as to other appropriate criteria to establish the threshold level for companies to enter into the reporting system under the Exchange Act which would complement or be substituted for the present system. Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan G. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received before September 30, 1986 and should refer to File No. S7-16-86. (Rel. 34-23407)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

JOSEPH H. STAFFORD SUSPENDED

In connection with a pending administrative proceeding, the Commission entered Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Joseph H. Stafford, a registered representative formerly employed by a registered broker-dealer in Houston, Texas. The Order was entered following an Offer of Settlement submitted by Stafford wherein he consented, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Order for Proceedings, to findings of violations and the sanctions imposed.

On the basis of the Order for Proceedings and the Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Stafford wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of municipal securities to his customers. Stafford, among other things, misrepresented the safety of such investments and failed to disclose the existence of litigation adversely affecting the issuers of these securities.

Based on the above findings and the Offer of Settlement, Stafford was censured, suspended from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer for 75 calendar days and barred from association with any of these entities in a supervisory or proprietary capacity, provided that he may reapply after one year. A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to acquire up to \$15 million of notes issued by customers for financing certain conservation measures during the period ending December 31, 1989. SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Southwestern Electric Power Company, subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to enter into an installment sale agreement in connection with the issuance and sale of \$81,700,000 of fixed term pollution control bonds to refund a prior series of adjustable rate bonds in the same principal amount. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-86-12) which would require that its money settlements be made in immediately available funds. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 30. (Rel. 34-23399)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia became effective in accordance with Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change (SR-SCCP-86-10) enhances SCCP's Municipal Bond Comparison System by adding or revising procedures for when-issued trades, extended settlement trades, one-sided delete, price figuration and syndicate takedown trades.
