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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST AMERICAN MONETARY CORPORATION AND JOHN P. ROBERTS

The Commission instituted proceedings and imposed remedial sanctions against American Monetary Corporation, a registered investment adviser, and its president, John P. Roberts, both of Marietta, Georgia. The respondents consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the allegations.

The Commission found that the respondents wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and that American, aided and abetted by Roberts, violated the reporting, books and records and custody and possession of client's funds provisions of the Advisers Act. The Commission found that the respondents had misrepresented the use of clients' funds and had diverted and misappropriated over \$180,000 of clients' funds.

The Commission revoked the registration of American and barred Roberts from association with any regulated entity. (Rel. IA-1040)

### ELLIS MEISTER AND ROBERT DEJONGE SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Ellis E. Meister and Robert J. DeJonge, both of Grand Rapids, Michigan and formerly registered representatives of broker-dealers located there. Without admitting or denying any of the findings, Meister and DeJonge consented to an order permanently barring Meister from association with a broker or dealer with the right to reapply in two years and suspending DeJonge from association with a broker or dealer for 12 months.

The Commission found that Meister and DeJonge violated and aided and abetted violations of the registration provisions in connection with the offer and sale of securities issued by Horizon Oil & Gas, Inc. It further found that they misrepresented material facts regarding the risk and the return associated with an investment. (Rel. 34-23657)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST AMERICAN MONETARY CORPORATION AND JOHN P. ROBERTS

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on September 29 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against American Monetary Corporation, a registered investment adviser, and its president, John P. Roberts, both of Marietta, Georgia. The Final Judgment enjoins American and Roberts from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and the reporting, books and records and custody provisions of the Advisers Act. American and Roberts consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The complaint alleged that American and Roberts diverted and misappropriated clients' funds and that American's books and records were false and misleading. (SEC v. American Monetary Corporation and John P. Roberts, Civil Action No. 86-2082A, USDC NCGA, filed September 29, 1986). (LR-11233)

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on September 25 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Georgia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Vidalia Sweets Brand, Inc. (formerly New Bros., Inc.), headquartered in Vidalia, Georgia. The company, having consented to the relief without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, is enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, from failing to file or filing false reports, and from falsifying its books and records.

The complaint alleged the filing of a false and misleading Form 10-K for 1984 in order to conceal the spoilage of assets, namely onions, the filing of late and misleading Form 8-Ks, making false statements to the company's outside auditors during the preparation of its financial statements, and falsifying its books and records. Injunctive relief was granted against further violations of the antifraud provisions even though no actual purchases and sales of the company's common stock occurred after the filing of the false reports since its past conduct posed a threat of violations in the future. (SEC v. Vidalia Sweets Brand, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. CV686-33, USDC SDGA). (LR-11250)

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### **UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT**

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to comment on the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 25 issues. 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## **SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS**

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### **APPROVAL/ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES**

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-24) and granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-86-24) to increase position and exercise limits in foreign currency options to 100,000 contracts on the Phlx and 50,000 contracts on the CBOE. 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## **TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES**

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### **CITICORP**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 10 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeships of the United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures, three pooling and servicing agreements each dated July 1, 1986 and two pooling and servicing agreements each dated August 1, 1986 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The Trust Company is currently acting as trustee under the following four indentures dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
