ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

INITIAL DECISION BARS JAMES E. CAVALLO

Administrative Law Judge Max O. Regensteiner has issued an initial decision barring James E. Cavallo from association with a broker or dealer, with the proviso that after 18 months, he may apply to become so associated in a non-supervisory and non-proprietary capacity, upon a satisfactory showing of adequate supervision. This action was based on findings that in 1980 and 1981, Cavallo, while employed as a salesman by a registered broker-dealer, made false and misleading representations in the offer and sale of common stock of Reserve Oil and Minerals Corporation.

The initial decision is subject to Commission review on petition of a party or on the Commission's own initiative.

LEONARD B. BEDNAR BARRED

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Leonard G. Bednar. The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Bednar in which he admitted that he had been found guilty, on February 4, 1983, of making false, material declarations to a federal grand jury and making false entries on the books and records of Stix & Co., Inc., a registered broker-dealer. The Commission barred Bednar from associating with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer with the proviso that, after five years, Bednar may apply for association in a non-supervisory capacity.

A SIPC trustee was appointed to take control of Stix, formerly a St. Louis broker-dealer, in 1981 after the \$16 million looting of Stix was uncovered by federal authorities. (Rel. 34-24261)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INFORMATION FILED AGAINST IRA LEE HUNTER

On January 28 an information was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Ira Lee Hunter of Miami, Florida, charging him with two counts of securities fraud in violation of Sections 17(a)(3) and 24) of the Securities Act of 1933. On March 23 a plea of guilty was filed in which Hunter agreed to plead guilty to the information. Hunter was previously the branch office manager of a registered broker-dealer.

The information alleges that while acting as a branch manager, Hunter, among other things, caused unauthorized checks to be drawn on customers' funds on account with the registered broker-dealer and thereafter forged the customers' endorsements on those checks, keeping the proceeds for his own use, and misappropriated and converted a net of \$236,429 in the course of his scheme.

Hunter previously consented to a bar from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities broker, or municipal securities dealer without admitting or denying the allegations against him [Rel. 34-20908, dated April 30, 1984]. (SEC v. Ira Lee Hunter, Case No. 87-0043-CR-SPPELLMAN, SDFL). (LR-11388)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE NORTHWESTERN MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, NML Equity Services, Inc., NML Variable Annuity Account B, NML Variable Annuity Account 1, and NML Variable Annuity Account 2 for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to combine Accounts 1 and 2 into Account B. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Southwestern Electric Power Company, a subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell up to 400,000 shares of its preferred stock, \$100 par. (Rel. 35-24352 - March 24)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Gulf Power Company and Mississippi Power Company, to issue and sell from time-to-time through March 31, 1989 short-term notes to banks and, in the case of Gulf and Mississippi, commercial paper to dealers up to an aggregate principal amount of \$100 million for Southern, \$50 million for Gulf, and \$85 million for Mississippi. The commercial paper will be issued and sold pursuant to an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Subsection (a)(5). Gulf and Mississippi also may effect short-term borrowings in connection with the financing of certain pollution control facilities through the issuance by public entities of their revenue bonds anticipation notes. Southern also has been authorized through March 31, 1988 to make capital contributions to its subsidiaries, Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf, and Mississippi, in amounts not to exceed \$70 million, \$300 million, \$20 million, and \$25 million, respectively. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 21 to comment on the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Philadelphia Stock Exchange - two issues. WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of MAYFLOWER TRANSIT, INC. to withdraw the 7-7/8% convertible subordinated debentures, due 2006, of Mayflower Group, Inc. from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24285)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-87-7) to expand to the February and March cycles the stock options pilot program that provides for four expiration months - including two near term months - and to extend the pilot for one year. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 6. (Rel. 34-24288)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-87-7) amending Section 66(b) of its Uniform Practice Code to reduce the time period for setting syndicate accounts from 120 days to 90 days. (Rel. 34-24290)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 20 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeships of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures and a pooling and servicing agreement dated January 1, 1987 under which loans have been issued, are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The four indentures are dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
