CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST PAUL T. VAN WINKLE

The Denver Regional Office announced that on March 27 Chief Judge Sherman G. Fine-silver, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, signed an order of permanent injunction against Paul T. Van Winkle, of Denver, Colorado, enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Van Winkle consented to the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint. The complaint alleged, among other things, that Van Winkle and Paul E. Sherrod, also of Denver, violated the antifraud provisions by causing Time Technology, Inc., a Colorado corporation headquartered in Grand Rapids, Michigan, to file a false and misleading registration statement for the initial public offering of the company's stock, and a false and misleading quarterly report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended May 31, 1985. The action is continuing against Sherrod. (SEC v. Paul T. Van Winkle and Paul E. Sherrod, USDC CO, Civil Action No. 87-F-378). (LR-11400)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CERTIFICATE OF DEPOSIT TRUST, SERIES 1 (AND SUBSEQUENT SERIES)

An order has been issued declaring that Certificate of Deposit Trust, Series 1 (and Subsequent Series) has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15680 - April 14)

FIRST TRUST FOREIGN INVESTOR U.S. GOVERNMENT FUND, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 8 to request a hearing on an application by First Trust Foreign Investor U.S. Government Fund L.P. (Applicant). The application seeks an order exempting Applicant's Managing General Partners and any successor Managing General Partners which may be elected in the future from the provisions of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act to the extent they would be deemed "interested persons", as defined in Section 2(a)(19), of Applicant or its investment adviser or principal underwriter solely because they are general partners in Applicant. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a short-term borrowing program proposed by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, five of its operating subsidiaries, Central Power and Light Company, Southwestern Electric Power Company, Public Services Company of Oklahoma, West Texas Utilities Company and Transok, Inc., and its service company subsidiary, Central and South West Service, Inc. The short term borrowing program would be coordinated through the use of a money pool, and funds for the pool would be available from surplus funds in the treasuries of the operating subsidiaries, surplus funds from the treasury of CSW, proceeds from the sale of commercial paper notes by CSW, or bank borrowings by CSW or its subsidiaries. CSW has been granted an exception from competitive bidding requirements for the sale of commercial paper notes. (Rel. 35-24363 - April 2)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY; THE SOUTHERN COMPANY;
HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC INDUSTRIES, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24364, dated April 2: National Fuel Gas Company - a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Seneca Resources Corporation to amend their original proposal to issue and sell up to one million shares of National's common stock at competitive bidding to recapitalize Seneca, by allowing National to negotiate a public offering of the stock; The Southern Company - a registered holding company, for an extension of time through March 31, 1989 of the authority previously granted to Southern by order dated March 3, 1986 (Rel. 35-24038) to issue and sell through March 31, 1987 up to 2,500,000 shares of authorized but unissued shares of common stock, par value \$5.00, at competitive bidding. That order reserved jurisdiction over the issuance and sale of 7,500,000 shares of authorized but unissued common stock pending completion of the record; and Hawaiian Electric Industries, Inc. - an exempt public-utility holding company, and its subsidiary, Hawaiian Electric Renewable Systems, Inc., to acquire all of the capital stock of Lalamilo Ventures, Inc., which operates a windfarm on the Island of Hawaii.

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have become immediately effective by: The Midwest Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-87-2) adjusting its trade recording fees, including the discount schedule. (Rel. 34-24330); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-87-5) amending its rules regarding the calculation of margin on foreign currency settlement obligations that Clearing Members and their customers elect to settle through its Delivery-versus-Payment (DVP) system. The proposal also amends OCC rules that give Clearing Members' customers access to the DVP system. (Rel. 34-24332)

SUMMARY EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENTS

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
