CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES AIRNADO, INC. AND MARVIN D. SKELTON

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint on June 5 in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, Southern Division, seeking permanent injunctions against Airnado, Inc. and Marvin D. Skelton. Airnado is a corporation which has its principal place of business in Flint, Michigan. Its stock is listed by the National Quotations Bureau (NOB) in the "pink sheets." Skelton, until recently a resident of Fenton, Michigan, has served as chairman of the board, president, and chief operating officer of Airnado since 1979. The Complaint alleges that Airnado violated and Skelton violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 in connection with the sale of Airnado common stock.

According to the Complaint, Airnado and Skelton made and caused to be made material misstatements and omissions concerning, among other things, the financial condition of Airnado; its operations; projections of its revenues; the valuation of Airnado's common stock; and the valuation of Airnado's assets. (SEC v. Airnado, Inc. and Marvin D. Skelton, Civil Action No. 87-40163, filed June 5, 1987). (LR-11462)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

STEVEN A. KUNA, JR. SENTENCED

The Chicago Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois announced that on June 2 Steven A. Kuna, Jr., of Grand Rapids, Michigan, was sentenced in federal court in Chicago, Illinois, to three years incarceration, following the revocation of his probation for mail fraud. While on probation, Kuna had violated the terms of his probation by obtaining money from an investor by misrepresenting that the money would be used to trade in options.

Kuna was convicted on June 22, 1984 of five counts of mail fraud and one count of making false statements to the Commission in connection with his scheme to defraud the limited partners of Steven Kuna & Associates. He received four concurrent two-year prison terms followed by five years probation. Restitution of \$1.3 million was a condition of probation. (U.S. v. Steven A. Kuna, Jr., File No. 83 CR 921, NDIL).
