COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC TO REOPEN EDGAR SYSTEM COMPETITION

The Commission today announced that it will reopen, for 90 days, competition among potential vendors of the proposed electronic filing system, Edgar. The Commission is taking this action because of a proposed change in the level of federal funding for the Edgar contract. (Press Release 87-47)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DAVID H. SIEGEL CONSENTS TO SUSPENSION ARISING FROM MAGNA TECHNOLOGIES, INC. CASE

The Commission today suspended David H. Siegel from association with any broker, dealer, investment advisor, investment company, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer for 364 days. The suspension was based upon the July 10 entry by the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California of an order permanently enjoining Siegel from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Acts. According to the Commission's Complaint against Siegel and seven other defendants, filed in the Central District of California on May 6, Siegel, then acting president of Rothschild Equity Management, Inc. of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, participated in a massive market manipulation of the stock of Magna Technologies, Inc. Siegel consented to the District Court's final judgment and the Commission's suspension order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint or Order. (Rel. 34-24719)

PROCEEDINGS AGAINST ALLIED STORES CORPORATION SETTLED

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Allied Stores Corporation wherein Allied, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's June 29 Order Instituting Proceedings [see Release 34-24648], consented to Findings and an Order requiring Allied to comply with Section 14(d)(4) of the Exchange Act and Rule 14d-9.

The Commission found that Allied violated Section 14d-4 of the Exchange Act and Rule 14d-9 by failing to amend promptly a Schedule 14D-9 filed with the Commission in response to a tender offer to disclose negotiations and agreements with a third-party and a resolution of Allied's board in response to the tender offer. The Commission also found that the violations occurred prior to Allied becoming a wholly-owned subsidiary of Campeau Corporation.

The action is pending against George C. Kern, Jr., the remaining respondent.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DAVID H. SIEGEL CONSENTS TO INJUNCTION IN MAGNA TECHNOLOGIES, INC. CASE

The Commission announced today that on July 10 the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California permanently enjoined David H. Siegel from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Acts. According to the Commission's Complaint against Siegel and seven other defendants, filed on May 6, Siegel, then acting president of Rothschild Equity Management, Inc. of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, participated in a massive market manipulation of the stock of Magna Technologies, Inc. Siegel consented to the District Court's entry of the final judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint. (SEC v. Magna Technologies Inc., et al., USDC CDCA, Civil Action No. 87-2895 MRP, Gx). (LR-11490)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INTEGRATED MEDICAL VENTURE PARTNERS, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 7 to request a hearing on an application filed by Integrated Medical Venture Partners, L.P. (Partnership) and Integrated Health Care Management, Inc. (Managing General Partner), requesting an order declaring that the Independent General Partners of the Partnership are not interested persons of the Partnership solely by reason of their being general partners of the Partnership; that any limited partner of the Partnership that has the power to vote less than five percent of its outstanding shares not be deemed an affiliated person of the Partnership or any general partner thereof; and permitting the proposed acquisition by the Partnership from the Managing General Partner or its affiliate of certain initial venture capital investments. GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Energy Initiatives Incorporated, and GPU Nuclear Corporation, to limit the liability of the subsidiaries' directors and officers for money damages, and to broaden the indemnification of their officers, directors and employees as permitted by New Jersey law.
