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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST, AND AN OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM, GABRIEL RODRIGUEZ

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gabriel Rodriguez. The Commission simultaneously accepted Rodriguez' Offer of Settlement.

By his Offer, Rodriguez consented to the Commission findings that: (1) during various periods from about June 1985 to about February 1986, Rodriguez was associated with various broker-dealers registered with the Commission under Section 15(b) of the Exchange Act; and (2) on May 29, 1986, Rodriguez was convicted, after a guilty plea in the Nassau County Court, of grand larceny in the third degree (New York Penal law §155.30), People v. Rodriguez, SCI No. 63552, Nassau County Court, May 29, 1986.

Rodriguez consented to a bar from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer in any capacity with the right to reapply after the greater of ten years from the date of the Final Order or completion of his penal sanction, which includes the repayment of \$131,347.12. 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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### WILLIAM L. CAMPBELL CONVICTED OF CRIMINAL CONTEMPT

The Denver Regional Office announced that on July 22 U.S. District Judge Robert J. McNichols, Eastern District of Washington, convicted William L. Campbell of one count of criminal contempt and acquitted him on a second count. Campbell was found guilty of willfully exchanging unregistered securities for property knowing that they would be distributed to members of the public prior to being registered, in violation of an injunction entered on July 10, 1968. The second clause of the injunction precluded any "exchange" of unregistered shares regardless of whether an exemption might apply. Campbell was found not guilty of having sold unregistered securities without an available exemption.

The criminal contempt action against Campbell alleged that he had sold and exchanged unregistered shares of Master Security Services, Inc. of Las Vegas, Nevada for cash and an interest in an automobile dealership. The conviction was entered following a trial to the court. Sentencing for Campbell was set for August 31, 1987. (SEC v. William L. Campbell, USDC EDWA, Criminal No. 86-002-1). (LR-11513)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### PROVIDENT MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF PHILADELPHIA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 8 to request a hearing on an application by Provident Mutual Life Insurance Company of Philadelphia, et al., for an order approving the terms of certain offers by Applicants to exchange variable life insurance contracts issued through the Scheduled Separate Accounts for somewhat different variable life insurance contracts issued through the Modified Separate Accounts and permitting the participation of Applicants in such offers of exchange, and an offer of exemption from the provisions of Section 22(d) to permit the exchanges. ### ML-LEE ACQUISITION FUND, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by ML-Lee Acquisition Fund, L.P. (Partnership), a business development company, Mezzanine Investments, L. P. (Managing General Partner), and Thomas H. Lee Advisors, Inc. (Investment Adviser) declaring that the independent general partners of the Partnership are not, within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, "interested persons" of the Partnership, the Managing General Partner, the Investment Adviser, or Merrill Lynch Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated. ### CENTRAL BANK FOR COOPERATIVES

An order has been issued for Central Bank For Cooperatives, Columbia Bank for Cooperatives, Jackson Bank For Cooperatives, Louisville Bank For Cooperatives, St. Louis Bank for Cooperatives and Wichita Bank For Cooperatives (Applicants), on behalf of certain trusts (Trusts) established or to be established by Applicants, conditionally exempting the Trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act other than Sections 26 (with certain exceptions), 36, 37 and (to the extent necessary to implement the foregoing sections) 38 through 53 thereof in connection with the issuance of certificates by the Trusts to Applicants and their subsequent resale to the public by Applicants. Each Trust will hold a single note guaranteed by the Rural Electrification Administration evidencing loans used to refinance borrowings from the Federal Financing Bank. (Rel. IC-15919 - Aug. 12)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM; GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION APPALACHIAN POWER COMPANY; THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24436, dated August 6: New England Electric System (NEES) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, New England Energy Incorporated (NEEI). NEEI will make loans of up to \$25 million to New England Collier Company, a joint venture of NEEI and Keystone Shipping Co., to redeem certain bonds. NEEI and NEES will enter into a \$15 million equity funding agreement; General Public Utilities Corporation - a registered holding company, to guarantee certain obligations of GPU Service Corporation and GPU Nuclear Corporation, its subsidiaries, arising under their employee benefit plans; Appalachian Power Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue and sell through December 31, 1988 an aggregate amount of up to \$180 million of first mortgage bonds, preferred stock and/or unsecured long-term notes; and The Connecticut Light and Power Company and Western Massachusetts Electric Company - subsidiaries of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to enter into a \$350 million revolving credit agreement.

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-32) to extend for one year the stock options pilot program that provides for four expiration months including two near-term months. (Rel. 34-24788)

## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b) (3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-CBOE-87-31) to revise its policy regarding exemptions to position and exercise limits.
