ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ORDER MODIFYING PRIOR ORDER IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS

On September 30, 1987, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Finding, Opinion and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against F.N. Wolf & Co., Inc. F.N. Wolf consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein. The Order required F.N. Wolf to comply with the undertakings contained in its Offer of Settlement. Among the various undertakings contained in its Offer of Settlement, F.N. Wolf undertook to submit to the Commission its Compliance Manual as amended to reflect the recommendations of a Special Review Person. F.N. Wolf's submission of its Compliance Manual to the Commission was due February 15, 1988. F.N. Wolf, through its Counsel, requested that submission of the Manual be delayed until February 29, 1988. The Commission, under all circumstances, granted F.N. Wolf's request. (Rel. 34-25392)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WILLIAM CROWDER, OTHERS

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted against William Edgar Crowder, and two companies of which he is the president and beneficial owner, Bretcourt Securities Corporation, formerly a registered broker-dealer, and Bretcourt Financial Planning, Inc., a registered investment adviser. The Order alleges willful violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 in connection with offerings of interests in real estate limited partnerships and the misappropriation of offering proceeds for Crowder's personal and other undisclosed uses, alleges that Crowder and his two companies were permanently enjoined from further violations of this type in a Commission enforcement action [see LR-11575], and alleges that, in a state agency enforcement action, Crowder was permanently enjoined from securities fraud violations, from filing false documents with that state agency, and from certain securities sales activities.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial actions should be taken by the Commission. (Rel. 34-25393)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER NAMES ROBERT VINCENT YEO, JR., OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on February 18 in the U.S District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan seeking temporary, preliminary, and permanent injunctions against Robert Vincent Yeo, Jr., First Continental Group, Inc., First Continental Financial Corporation of America (Continental Financial), First Continental Securities Corporation of America (Continental Securities), First Continental Realty Income Fund I Limited Partnership, and First Continental 1986 Management Associates. On February 19, Judge Avern Cohn issued a Temporary Restraining Order against the defendants, froze their assets, and appointed a receiver for all of the defendant entities, except Continental Securities.

The Complaint alleges that from August 1986 until the present, defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, offering and selling limited partnership interests, promissory and short-term notes, raising over \$3 million from approximately 100 investors. The defendants made materially misleading statements and omitted to state material facts concerning the use of proceeds, the risk of the investments, and that the investments were being made. Yeo and Continental Financial, a registered investment adviser, were also alleged to have violated the provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. (SEC v. Robert Vincent Yeo, Jr., et al., USDC EDM, Civil Action No. 88 CV 70585 DT). (LR-11674)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE AMERICAN EXPRESS FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by The American Express Funds (Funds) and American Express Service Corporation (American Express) for an order approving certain offers of exchange among the present Funds and any future investment companies for which American Express serves as investment manager or distributor, and permitting the imposition of an administrative fee. CENVILL INVESTORS, INC.

An order has been issued exempting certain subsidiaries Cenvill Investors, Inc. may form from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and sale of equity interests, subject to conditions. (Rel. IC-16291 - Feb. 29)

AMERICAN BENEFIT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Benefit Life Insurance Company, American Benefit Variable Annuity Account, and American Republic Equities Corporation for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from net asset value. (Rel. IC-16292 - Feb. 29)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a modification of one of the undertakings by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, contained in a prior Commission order which authorized Southern and its subsidiary, SV Ventures, Inc., to acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Savannah Electric and Power Company [Rel. 35-24579, dated February 19]. The supplemental order also notes a correction to the record by the applicants-declarants concerning the estimated fees of the proposed acquisition. (Rel. 35-24579 - Feb. 26)

SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC.

An order has been issued on a proposal by System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI) and its parent, Middle South Utilities, Inc., whereby SERI will enter into a nuclear-fuel lease and Middle South will guarantee SERI's obligations under the lease. (Rel. 35-24591 - Feb. 29)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 18 to comment on the application of the Cincinnati Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in 20 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed the following proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: (SR-NYSE-87-38) to revise its Specialist Job Description. (Rel. 34-25398); (SR-NYSE-88-2) to prohibit index arbitrage-related stock transactions on days when the Dow Jones Industrial Average moves 50 or more points from the previous day's close.

(Rel. 34-25400); and (SR-NYSE-87-31) to require a copy of a member organization's annual internal report, covering supervisory and compliance efforts, to be furnished to control persons of the member organization. (Rel. 34-25402)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 29.
