### COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED RULES 203(b)(1)-1 AND 203(b)(3)-2

The Commission is proposing for public comment Rules 203(b)(1)-1 and 203(b)(3)-2 under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The proposed rules would exempt from federal registration under the Act certain small advisers registered in each state in which they do business who, among other things, have a limited number of clients and funds under management. The Commission is also proposing to relieve advisers exempt under these rules from the Act's recordkeeping rule, advertising rule, cash solicitation rule, disciplinary disclosure rule, and the Act's restrictions on principal and agency cross transactions.

Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan A. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Stop 6-9, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received by November 22 and should refer to File No. S7-19-88. All submissions will be available for inspection in the Public Reference Room. (Rel. IA-1140)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.; THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY; LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 11 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24714, dated September 15: THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC. - a registered holding company, and its direct and indirect subsidiaries; Commonwealth Propane, Inc., a propane distribution subsidiary of Columbia; Lynchburg Gas Company and its propane distribution subsidiary, Lynco Development Corporation; whereby Lynco will be merged into Commonwealth; THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to finance the issuance and sale of up to \$10 million of pollution control revenue bonds; and LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY (LP&L) - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to provide alternative collateral to secure certain outstanding pollution control revenue bonds that the Parish of St. Charles, Louisiana, issued to finance pollution control facilities. In order to secure the revenue bonds, LP&L proposes to: (a) issue

and pledge new series of its first mortgage bonds; or (b) extend the existing, or procure new, letters of credit with altered terms; and/or (c) obtain insurance for one or more of the banks participating in the letters of credit. LP&L also proposes, if advantageous at the time, to effect such financing on an unsecured basis.

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
