COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

PRESS BRIEFING ON EDGAR PROJECT

The Commission today announced that it will hold a press briefing on the EDGAR project on Thursday, March 9 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, 450 5th Street, NW, Washington, DC. John O. Penhollow, Director of the Office of EDGAR Management, will introduce each of the team members selected on January 3 to implement the operational EDGAR Project, and make remarks on the project. Mr. Penhollow, and members of the team of The BDM Corporation, Mead Data Central, Sorg and Bechtel will be available to answer questions on the EDGAR project. Technical representatives from Stratus Computer, Inc. will also attend the briefing and be available for questions.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM L. KICKLIGHTER, JR., OTHERS SUSPENDED

Administrative Law Judge Jerome K. Soffer issued an initial decision suspending from association with any broker or dealer William L. Kicklighter, Jr. for 120 days, and Robert Q. Brown and Terry G. Eurich, for 45 days each. All are from Atlanta, Georgia.

The sanctions imposed were based upon findings that they, while associated with Hereth, Orr & Jones, Inc., a registered broker-dealer in Atlanta, violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the sale of non-rated industrial revenue bonds, the proceeds of which were to be used in the construction of a life-care nursing facility in Polk County, Florida.

STOP ORDER ISSUED AS TO POST-EFFECTIVE AMENDMENT OF SCORPION TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Stop Order in connection with a post-effective amendment to a registration statement filed in September 1987 by Scorpion Technologies, Inc., a Colorado corporation based in San Jose, California. The Order suspends the effectiveness of the post-effective amendment.

The Order makes findings that the post-effective amendment includes untrue statements of material facts and omits to state material facts concerning Scorpion's acquisitions of Network Computer Support, Inc. and Hallock Systems Company, Inc. including, among other things, (1) Scorpion's failure to acquire all of Hallock Systems' outstanding shares; (2) Scorpion's defaults under the two acquisition agreements; (3) material modifications of the two acquisition agreements; and (4) the risk posed by Scorpion's defaults under the two acquisition agreements that the company would lose most of its assets. Scorpion consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations therein. (Rel. 33-6817)

PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST ROBERT L. SMITH

The Commission, in a previously instituted public administrative proceeding against Robert L. Smith, a principal of a registered broker-dealer, accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Smith wherein he consented to an Order imposing sanctions.

The Order finds that Smith was enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California, on December 2, 1986, from future violations of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-6. Smith was also permanently enjoined on February 1 by the same court from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-6, and Section 12(k) of the Exchange Act. The latter injunction was entered with Smith's consent.

This matter arises out of Smith's (1) sale and distribution of unregistered Gay International, Inc. stock, (2) manipulation of the stock of Gay International, and (3) effecting transactions in Gay International stock during a Commission suspension of trading.

The Order bars Smith from association with any broker or dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer, with the right to reapply for association after 18 months. (Rel. 34-26553)

ALVIE LORETTA ASTA SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Alvie Loretta Asta, a registered representative. Simultaneous with the institution of the proceedings, Asta submitted and the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised in the proceedings. Asta consented to an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds that on September 29, 1988, she was convicted of two felony counts of wire fraud in the case of U.S. v. Alvie Loretta Asta (EDPA, Case No. CR 88-13-1).

The Commission permanently barred Asta from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-26554)

BRIAN H. KAY BARRED

The Commission instituted Rule 2(e) proceedings and issued an Order permanently denying Brian H. Kay the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission as an attorney. Kay consented to the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, except for the finding that he had been enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California on February 3 from aiding and abetting violations of Section 5(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5.

The Complaint alleged that Kay fabricated a letter on Commission letterhead and forged a Commission staff attorney's signature. The fabricated letter stated that a Form S-18 registration statement, prepared by Kay and filed with the Commission on behalf of Kay's client, Cytotech Corporation, was effective. Kay sent the fabricated letter to principals of Cytotech. The company thereafter offered and sold unregistered securities [SEC v. Brian H. Kay, Civil Action No. 89-0611 MRP, Kx, CDCA]. (Rel. 34-26555)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

EDWIN D. WOOD II, OTHERS TEMPORARILY RESTRAINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on February 6 Judge Robert H. Bell, Western District of Michigan, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Edwin D. Wood II, Universal Leasing Co., Inc. (ULC), Universal Financial Services, Inc. (UPS), and The Franklin Group International, Inc. The Order enjoins defendants from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, freezes their assets, and requires them to provide an accounting to the Court.

The Complaint alleges that as part of a fraudulent scheme, defendants offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of bonds and participating interests in certificates of deposits to numerous investors. It also alleges that defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, the returns to be expected, the risks associated with the investment, and Wood's previous criminal convictions. It further alleges that defendants falsely represented that the investments were secured by a certificate of deposit held by an independent custodian. The Court set a hearing for a preliminary injunction for February 21. (SEC v. Edwin D. Wood II, et al., WDMI, Civil Action No. 89-30016CA). (LR-12001)

MAURICE KLABUNDE ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on February 2 Judge Clyde S. Cahill, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Maurice Klabunde. Klabunde consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint. The Order enjoins Klabunde from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The

Order also requires that Klabunde disgorge all funds received from investors; however, in lieu of disgorgement the Court accepted Klabunde's affidavit that he offered restitution of funds to all investors whom he solicited. (SEC v. Worldwide Investment Research, Ltd., et al., Civil Action No. 87-1764-C-4). (LR-12002)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRINCIPAL MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued to Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company (PMLIC), Princor Government Securities Income Fund, Inc. (Fund), and Principal Mutual, Inc. which permits the Fund, subject to certain conditions, to purchase mortgage-backed securities guaranteed by the Government National Mortgage Association at prices which will be 1/64 of a dollar less than the prices at which PMLIC would sell such securities to dealers. (Rel. IC-16827 - Feb. 21)

MILLICOM INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Millicom Incorporated for a temporary order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act until March 31. (Rel. IC-16828 - Feb. 22)

WNC CALIFORNIA HOUSING TAX CREDITS, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by WNC California Housing Tax Credits, L.P. (the Partnership) and WNC Resources, Inc., for an order exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-16829 - Feb. 22)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Phlx-89-2) to amend and restate the requirement of Phlx specialists and registered options traders to execute public customer market and marketable limit orders to a minimum of ten contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 27. (Rel. 34-26566)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
