## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

### OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, MAY 3, 1989 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the May 3 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to issue a Supplemental Memorandum Opinion and Order with respect to a post-effective amendment to an application-declaration filed by Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, and its wholly-owned electric utility subsidiary company, EUA Power Corporation. EUA and EUA Power propose that the Commission release jurisdiction, as set forth in the Commission's Memorandum No. 24641, and authorize EUA Power to issue 17-1/2% Series C Secured Notes (Series C Notes) on May 15, 1989 in the amount of \$26,107,102 and on November 15, 1989, in the amount of \$29,145,316, in lieu of the semi-annual cash interest payments due on those dates on EUA Power's outstanding 17-1/2% Series B Secured Notes and Series C Notes. EUA Power further proposes to issue and sell, and EUA proposes to acquire, through May 14, 1990, up to an additional \$15.6 million of Class A 25% Cumulative Convertible Preferred Stock (Preferred Stock) in order to fund EUA Power's share of costs associated with its joint ownership interest in the Seabrook Nuclear Power Project and to maintain EUA Power's debt/equity ratio. In connection therewith, EUA proposes to finance its acquisition of EUA Power's Preferred Stock through the issuance, through December 31, 1989, of up to an additional \$15.6 million of short-term notes to banks under its existing lines of credit. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST J. DUDLEY AND BRADLEY E. BOHLING

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on March 29 the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah entered orders permanently restraining and enjoining J. Dudley and Bradley E. Bohling from violating certain of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Defendants consented to these orders without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Complaint. The Complaint variously charges defendants with participating in a pre-arranged merger agreement and false closing, which rendered false and misleading a Form S-18 registering a blank check offering by Faspag, Inc.

As further alleged in the Complaint, Dudley acquired control of Faspag in connection with the pre-arranged merger agreement and, thereafter, caused Faspag to file a false and misleading post-effective amendment which concealed the existence of the pre-arranged merger agreement. Bohling facilitated the pre-arranged merger agreement by arranging the meeting of the parties to this agreement and obtaining nominee shareholders to falsely close out Faspag's initial public offering. The Complaint also charges six other individuals and the issuer for their varying participation in this scheme. (SEC v. Faspag, Inc., et al., Civ. No. 88-C-897J, D. Utah). (LR-12071)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 15 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24869, dated April 20: NORTHEAST UTILITIES (NU) - a registered holding company, and two of its subsidiaries, Charter Oak Energy, Inc. and Charter Oak Paris, Inc., to engage in the investment and participation in qualifying cogeneration facilities and in qualifying small power production facilities. NU and Charter Oak propose for Charter Oak to issue and NU to acquire 100 shares of Charter Oak common stock for \$10,000. NU proposes to invest up to an aggregate amount of \$7.5 million in Charter Oak for each of the four years in the period ending December 31, 1992. Charter Oak and Charter Oak Paris propose for Charter Oak Paris to issue and Charter Oak to acquire 100 shares of Charter Oak Paris common stock for \$10,000. Charter Oak Paris is being formed in order to acquire approximately 10% equity interest in a 213 megawatt gas-fired qualifying cogeneration facility in Paris, Texas, at a cost not to exceed \$4 million.
