TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF ASAC CORPORATION

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of ASAC Corporation for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on February 23, 1990, and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on March 4, 1990. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of the aforementioned companies in view of questions that have been raised about recent market activity in the securities of ASAC, and about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the identities of the shareholders of ASAC and the beneficial ownership and control of the company's shares. MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY
