ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

GREGORY T. HARRY BARRED

The Commission has instituted and simultaneously settled administrative proceedings against Gregory T. Harry, formerly a registered representative with a registered broker-dealer in Salt Lake City, Utah. Harry consented to the entry of an Order which found: (1) that on July 6, 1989, he was convicted, pursuant to a guilty plea, of two counts of violating 15 U.S.C. Section 77q(a) and 18 U.S.C. Section 2; and (2) that on January 18, 1990, he was permanently enjoined, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Order bars Harry from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, transfer agent or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-28144)

PHILIP M. GEORGESON BARRED AND FINNET SECURITIES, INC. REGISTRATION REVOKED

The Commission announced that, on July 5, it instituted public administrative proceedings against Philip M. Georgeson (Georgeson) and FinNet Securities, Inc. (FinNet) pursuant to Sections 15(b)(4) and 15(b)(6) of the Exchange Act. In its Order Instituting Proceedings, the Commission found that Georgeson, president of FinNet, failed to cause FinNet to file, and FinNet did not otherwise file, an amendment to Form BD reporting financing received by FinNet from Power Securities Corporation (Power) in connection with a proposed acquisition or merger of FinNet with an affiliate of Power. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, Georgeson and FinNet submitted Offers of Settlement in which they consented to the entry of an Order by the Commission which (a) bars Georgeson from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, municipal securities broker or dealer, or governmental securities broker or dealer, with the proviso that

after one year from the date of the order, he may apply to become associated with any such entity, and (b) revokes FinNet's registration with the Commission as a broker-dealer. In the Matter of Philip M. Georgeson and FinNet Securities, Inc., File No. 3-7352. (Rel.-34-28180)

PATTERSON CAPITAL CORP., AND JOSEPH B. PATTERSON SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings pursuant to Advisers Act Sections 203(e) and 203(f) against Patterson Capital Corporation (PCC), a registered investment adviser located in Los Angeles, California, and Joseph B. Patterson, PCC's President. The Order finds that PCC improperly used commission dollars generated from client accounts (soft dollars) to pay for services outside the safe harbor of Section 28(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and that PCC failed to disclose the arrangement as required in its Form ADV or in PCC's brochures sent to clients. The soft dollar payments in issue were provided to a former registered investment adviser, Financial Selected Services (FSS), in exchange for training in marketing techniques provided from September to December 1985 to Patterson and other PCC employees.

PCC and Patterson have submitted an Offer of Settlement, which the Commission has determined to accept, in which they neither admit nor deny the Commission's findings and consent to be censured. PCC also consents to file an amended Form ADV disclosing the soft dollar arrangement with FSS, to timely and fully disclose all soft dollar arrangements in the future, and to file an affidavit of compliance with the Commission's Los Angeles Regional Office (Re. IA-1235)

ERNST & WHINNEY AND MICHAEL L. FERRANTE, C.P.A, SANCTIONED

Administrative Law Judge Jerome K. Soffer has issued an initial decision barring the practice offices of Ernst & Whinney located within its New York region (including its White Plains Office) from accepting or undertaking any new professional engagements for the period of 45 days. The same decision ordered that Michael L. Ferrante, C.P.A., the managing partner of the White Plains practice office, be censured.

The sanctions imposed were based upon findings that the respondents named had engaged in improper professional conduct arising out of audits performed by Ernst & Whinney of the 1980 and 1981 financial statements of United States Surgical Corporation of Norwalk, Connecticut, resulting in the issuance of unqualified audit reports on statements which were incorrect for the reason that they significantly and improperly overstated income.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES WILLIAM P. DILLON

The Commission announced the filing of a civil action for injunctive and other equitable relief against William P. Dillon, alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act, the Securities Exchange Act and the Investment Advisers Act by manipulating the price of the stock of CopyTele, Inc., a development stage company traded on NASDAQ. The Complaint alleges that Dillon manipulated the stock price by buying and selling the stock among accounts within his control and by publishing newsletters which contained false and misleading statements regarding CopyTele. Without admitting or denying the allegations, Dillon consented to the

entry of a Final Judgment enjoining him from future violations. The Final Judgment also provides that, should Dillon publish investment newsletters, research reports or other materials, any such materials shall include a prominent statement describing the allegations in the Complaint and the substance of the Final Judgment. The Final Judgment also enjoins Dillon from buying CopyTele securities and, for a period of five years, from buying securities on margin. Finally, the Final Judgment orders Dillon to pay restitution in the amount of \$350,000 but waives payment based upon Dillon's representations, under oath, that he is financially unable to pay any amount of restitution. PHILIP M. GEORGESON ENJOINED

The Commission announced the filing, on July 5, of a Complaint for Permanent Injunction in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Philip M. Georgeson (Georgeson), alleging that he violated Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act, Rule 15b3-1(b) and Form BD. The Complaint alleged that Georgeson, the president of FinNet Securities, Inc. (FinNet), a registered broker-dealer, failed to cause FinNet to file with the Commission an amendment to Form BD reporting financing received by FinNet from Power Securities Corporation (Power) in connection with a proposed acquisition or merger of FinNet with an affiliate of Power. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, Georgeson consented to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining and restraining him from future violations of Section 15(b) of the Exchange Act or the rules or forms promulgated thereunder.
