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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ACTION FILED AGAINST PETER E. BUTLER

The Commission filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York seeking injunctive relief and disgorgement of gains from Peter E. Butler. The Commission alleged that Butler violated antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 in connection with transactions in the common stock of Memory Metals, Inc. It was alleged that Butler engaged in a course of conduct operating as a fraud or in a scheme to defraud to maintain and increase the market price of the Memory Metals common stock. The Commission alleged that as a part thereof, Butler made misstatements, omitted to make necessary disclosures and engaged in other conduct, including an attempt to effect a short squeeze in the market for the stock. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and Commonwealth Gas Pipeline Corporation (CGP) and Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation (TCO), both of which are wholly owned subsidiaries of Columbia, to merge CGP into TCO, which will be the surviving company. ### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Electric System, (NEES), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Granite State Electric Company (Granite), Massachusetts Electric Company, The Narragansett Electric Company, NEES Energy, Incorporated, New England Electric Transmission Corporation, New England Energy Incorporated, New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company, Inc., New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation, New England Power Company and New England Power Service Company, whereby Granite seeks separate authority to increase, from \$7 million to \$10 million outstanding at any one time, its existing authority to issue short-term notes (Notes) to the NEES Money Pool (Pool) and/or banks and to issue and sell commercial paper through October 31, 1990, and the members of the Pool seek authority to acquire such Notes. ### LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Louisiana Power & Light Company, a subsidiary of Entergy Corporation (formerly Middle South Utilities, Inc.), a

registered holding company, to invest up to \$1.3 million, inclusive of previously authorized amounts of \$475,000, in a joint project designed to evaluate the feasibility of a joint venture to license and construct a 1.5 million separative work unit centrifuge uranium enrichment plant. (Rel. 35-25113)

#### NORTHEAST UTILITIES

An order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, to create and acquire all of the common stock of a new wholly-owned subsidiary (HEC Inc.), which would acquire substantially all of the assets of HEC Energy Corporation, which currently provides energy management services to large institutional customers primarily in New England, for a purchase price currently estimated to be \$16 million, plus a premium not to exceed \$1,055,000. NU also requests authority, through June 30, 1993: (1) to make up to \$6 million in capital contributions to HEC Inc.; (2) for HEC Inc. to borrow up to \$15 million under a revolving credit/term loan agreement (Revolving Agreement) to be entered into with a bank or a group of banks; and (3) to make additional capital contributions to, or guarantees on behalf of, HEC Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$4 million. As an alternative to the Revolving Agreement, NU proposes that it lend up to \$15 million, through December 31, 1990, directly to HEC Inc. In addition, NU seeks authorization for its system service company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, to provide services to HEC Inc. (Rel. 35-25114)

#### GRANITE STATE ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Granite State Electric Company (Granite), a wholly owned subsidiary of New England Electric System, a registered holding company to, on or before December 31, 1991: (1) issue a long-term note (Note), at a rate not to exceed 12%, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$5 million, with a maturity of 1 to 30 years; or (2) engage in one or more interest rate protection mechanisms ("Rate Mechanisms") for a term not to exceed 10 years, in an amount not to exceed \$5 million, at a fixed or capped rate of interest of not more than 12% per annum. Granite requests authority to deviate from the Modifications of Policies Regarding Redemption Provisions of Long-Term Debt Securities Issued and Sold Under Holding Company Act (HCAR No. 16369, May 8, 1969) with regard to the redemption provisions of the proposed Note. Granite also requests an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under subsection (a)(5) thereunder with regard to the Note and the Rate Mechanisms. (Rel. 35-25115)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
