TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF TWO COMPANIES

The Commission announced pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 the temporary suspension of over-the-counter trading of the securities of Bancorp Mortgage Corporation of America and Unifirst Corporation, a Nevada corporation headquartered in Irvine, California; for a ten day period commencing at 9:30 a.m. (EDT), December 21, 1990 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on January 7, 1991. The

securities of both companies are traded on the OTC Bulletin Board and in the National Quotation Bureau pink sheets; neither company's securities are traded on a national securities exchange.

Trading has been suspended in view of questions that have been raised about recent market activity in the securities of the companies and about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the corporate histories and financial conditions of the companies, the identities of their shareholders, the beneficial ownership and control of the companies' shares and the claims for exemption from the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 made by these companies and pursuant to which their securities are trading.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLLEGE RETIREMENT EQUITIES FUND

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to the College Retirement Equities Fund (CREF), Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association of America (TIAA), TIAA-CREF Investment Management, Inc. and TIAA-CREF Individual & Institutional Services, Inc. approving a restructuring, whereby CREF will externalize the advisory, administrative and distribution services which are presently performed for CREF internally. These services will be performed by TIAA-CREF Investment Management, Inc. and TIAA-CREF Individual & Institutional Services, Inc., both of which are newly created, wholly controlled subsidiaries of TIAA. (Rel. IC-17906 - December 19)

WESTERN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Western Life Insurance Company, Variable Account D of Western Life Insurance Company (Variable Account) and AMEV Investors, Inc. from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Variable Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-17907 - December 19)

PANTEPEC INTERNATIONAL

An order has been issued denying a request for a hearing and declaring that, under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, Pantepec International, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company and that its registration under the Act has ceased to be in effect. (Rel. IC-17908 - December 20)

SOWER SERIES FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 14, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sower Series Fund, Inc. (Applicant) for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17910 - December 20)

SECURITY FIRST VARIABLE LIFE ACCOUNT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 14, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Security First Variable Life Account (Applicant) for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the Applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17909 - December 20)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Yankee Atomic Electric Company, a subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, registered holding companies, to extend until December 31, 1992 the time in which it may effect short-term borrowings in the aggregate principal amount of \$25 million outstanding at any one time. (35-25218)

HOLYOKE WATER POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Holyoke Water Power Company (Holyoke), a subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to finance certain pollution control facilities by borrowing the proceeds from pollution control revenue bonds (Bonds) to be issued by the Massachusetts Industrial Finance Agency in the principal amount of not more than \$15.3 million, such borrowings to be evidenced by Holyoke's issuance of a promissory note. Holyoke proposes to cause the Bonds to be offered under an exception from competitive bidding. In addition, Holyoke proposes to enter into a reimbursement agreement in connection with Letter of Credit arrangements for the redemption of the Bonds. (Rel. 35-25219)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and National's subsidiary companies, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation and Seneca Resources Corporation (Subsidiaries) to extend National's existing authority to issue and sell up to an aggregate principal amount \$130 million of its debt securities consisting of debentures and medium-term notes and to contribute the proceeds to the Subsidiaries, through June 30, 1991. (Rel. 35-25220)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: Participants Trust Company (SR-PTC-90-02) relating to the formation of a subsidiary (Rel. 34-28704); American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-30) to list and trade index warrants based on the FT-Actuaries Europe Index, a capitalization-weighted

index composed of 963 stocks representing issuers in 14 European countries (Rel. 34-28706); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-59) to expand the definition of "professional trading account" in the Rules of Practice and Procedure for the Small Order Execution System (SOES), to include criteria in addition to "day trading" (Rel 34-28709). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the weeks of December 17 and 24.
