LOCATION OF HEARING ON JUNE 20

EDGAR CONFERENCE

The SEC Office of EDGAR Management will hold the fourth EDGAR Conference in Room IC30 of the Judiciary Plaza Building at 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 26.

The Conference agenda will include brief overviews of the operational EDGAR development schedule, draft rule proposals, filing requirements and data dissemination plans. It will also include a demonstration and discussion of the EDGARLink software that filers may use to prepare, check correct and submit their electronic filings to the new EDGAR system.

1990 LOST AND STOLEN SECURITIES PROGRAM STATISTICS AVAILABLE

The 1990 aggregate dollar value of certificates reported as lost, stolen, missing or counterfeit under the Commission's Lost and Stolen Securities Program (Program) totalled \$2,593,031,073, a 21% increase from 1989. The data base, operated by the Securities Information Center (SIC), currently contains information on certificates with a reported value of approximately \$18.4 billion. There was a 153% increase in the number of certificates inquired about that matched reports of lost, stolen, missing or counterfeit securities, from 5,298 in 1989 to 13,418 in 1990. The dollar value of lost, stolen, missing or counterfeit securities matched with inquiries through the Commission's Program in 1990 totalled \$130,852,732, a 1,125% increase from the 1989 total of \$10,681,680.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EQUITABLE LIFE FUNDING CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 15 to request a hearing on an application filed by Equitable Life Funding Corporation for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would grant an exemption from all sections of the Act. The requested order would permit applicant to sell certain debt instruments and use the proceeds to finance the business activities of its parent company, Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States (Equitable), and certain companies controlled by Equitable. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Co. (Consolidated), a registered holding company. Consolidated proposes to guarantee all of the obligations of Virginia Natural Gas, Inc. (VNG), a gas public-utility subsidiary company of Consolidated, under a note agreement. The note agreement was entered into with the Aid Association of Lutherans (Association) in connection with VNG's issuance of \$20 million principal amount of 9.94% senior notes to the Association. THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company and its wholly owned subsidiary company, Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (SONOPCO). Southern and SONOPCO propose to finance SONOPCO with advances of up to \$10 million through March 31, 1993 from Southern or other lenders. It is also proposed that up to \$5 million of Southern's advances be converted into capital contributions or common stock of SONOPCO. (Rel. 35-25332)

ENEROP CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by Enerop Corporation (Enerop), a subsidiary of National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company. Enerop proposes to invest in Metscan, Inc. (Metscan), a company which develops and markets certain gas meter reading technology. Enerop proposes to acquire 17,000 additional shares of Metscan preferred stock (\$4 per share) for a total price of \$68,000. (Rel. 35-25332)

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Power Company (NEP), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of New England Electric System, a registered holding company. NEP proposes to extend its authorization to incur indebtedness in excess of 10% of the sum of the principal amount of all outstanding bonds and other secured indebtedness and the capital, premium, and retained earnings of NEP. This authorization would be subject to the proviso that all unsecured indebtedness of NEP not exceed 20% of such sum. (Rel. 35-25332)

OLS ENERGY-CHINO

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by OLS Energy-Chino, OLS Energy-Berkeley and OLS Energy-Camarillo, indirect subsidiary companies of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company to issue notes under certain revolving credit agreements through December 31, 1991. Additionally, OLS Energy-Chino and OLS Energy-Camarillo seek to extend until December 31, 1991 the time during which certain letters of credit may be outstanding. LEHIGH UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 9 to request a hearing on an application by Lehigh Utilities, Inc. (Lehigh), an indirect subsidiary of Security Savings and Loan Association, Scottsdale, Arizona, an institution under the receivership of the Resolution Trust Corporation.
