CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST JOHN WARD AND THOMAS WEBER

The Commission announced today that on May 6 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against John R. Ward and Thomas E. Weber.

Ward and Weber consented, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, to the entry of the Final Judgment, which enjoins them from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 13b2-1 and 13b2-2 thereunder, and from aiding and abetting violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13a-1, 13a-11, 13a-13 and 12b-20 thereunder. Ward also was permanently enjoined by consent from aiding and abetting violations of Sections 13(b)(2)(A) and 13(b)(2)(B) of the Exchange Act. In addition, both Ward and Weber consented to the entry of a court order prohibiting them, pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Exchange Act, from acting as officers or directors of any issuer that has a class of securities registered under Section 12 of the Exchange Act or that is required to file reports pursuant to Section 15(d) of the Exchange Act for five years from the date of entry of the Final Judgment. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH READY ASSETS TRUST ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Merrill Lynch Ready Assets Trust et al. for a conditional order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt applicants from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Act to permit Merrill Lynch Ready Assets Trust and other taxable money market funds to engage in principal transactions with dealers that are affiliated with the funds' investment advisers. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-15), which was granted accelerated approval to extend until November 5, 1992, operation of the temporary quotation linkage between the NASD and the London Stock Exchange. No substantive changes are approved for implementation during the extension. However, the additional time is intended to enable the sponsoring markets to consider various options and determine the future course of the experimental project. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30667)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-92-13) to provide for the listing of short-term, end-of-the-month expiration foreign currency options. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30669)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-92-09) to provide for settlement of S&P 500 Index Option contracts based on the opening prices of the component securities of the Index and increase the position limits for these contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30673)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-92-02) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange which, among other things, amends the PHLX's Options Floor Procedure Advice (OFPA) A-7 to make explicit the obligation of specialists to respond promptly to cancellation instructions for orders on the specialist's book. The proposal also provides for a fine schedule for infractions of this provision of the OFPA. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30670)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-30) submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to provide for the listing of long-term foreign currency options with expirations up to thirty-six months from the date of issuance. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30672)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
