COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

HEADQUARTERS OFFICES OF THE SEC TO CLOSE FOR INAUGURATION DAY

Headquarters Offices of the SEC in the Washington, D.C. area will be closed tomorrow, January 20, 1993, for Inauguration Day. Regional Offices of the SEC will remain open.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DOYCE CHESTNUTT ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Commission has instituted and simultaneously settled administrative proceedings against Doyce G. Chestnutt, a promoter of U.S. Mint, Inc. securities. U.S. Mint, Inc., now defunct, was formerly based in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Chestnutt consented to the entry of an Order which found that he failed to disclose his receipt of 15,000 shares of freetrading U.S. Mint stock in exchange for promoting U.S. Mint stock to investors and failed to disclose his receipt of a percentage of commissions a registered representative received on U.S. Mint transactions. The Order also found that Chestnutt made price predictions without a reasonable basis.

The Order requires Chestnutt to cease and desist from violating or causing violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. (Rels. 33-6973; 34-31727)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST RICHARD ROSEN

The Commission announced that on November 6, 1992 the Honorable Patricia C. Fawsett, U.S. District Judge for the Middle District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Richard Sol Rosen (Rosen) of Indiatlantic, Florida. Rosen consented to the entry of the Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint enjoining him from further violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The Final Judgment did not order disgorgement since Rosen paid full restitution in connection with the related state criminal matter.

The Commission alleged in its complaint filed on September 23, 1991 that between February 1990 and March 1991 Rosen obtained approximately \$112,000 from at least four investors for the purpose of purchasing securities. Rosen did not purchase the securities. Rosen instructed the investors to write checks payable to himself, deposited the checks into his personal bank account and subsequently disbursed such funds for personal uses. [SEC v. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER TREASURER AND ADVISER OF FLOWER BULB PRODUCER FOUND GUILTY

The Commission and Charles H. Turner, U.S. Attorney for the District of Oregon, announced that on December 18, 1992, following a three week trial, a federal jury in Portland, Oregon found Gordon H. Flattum, a former certified public accountant of Tacoma, Washington, guilty of six counts of conspiracy, securities fraud, filing false statements with the Commission and money laundering. Flattum was a former treasurer and adviser of Melridge, Inc. (Melridge), a failed flower bulb producer that was located in Aurora, Oregon and whose stock was traded on NASDAQ. The indictment stated that defendants and others had engaged in a conspiracy and scheme to falsify the financial condition of Melridge that took place from the beginning of 1983 through November 1987. Upon the findings of the jury, U.S. District Judge Helen J. Frye ordered Flattum taken into custody heeding prosecutors' concern that he might flee the country. Sentencing is set for February 22 at which time Flattum could face up to 45 years in prison and fines up to \$2.65 million.

George R. Heublein, the former chairman, president and chief executive officer of Melridge, who had been indicted along with Flattum, is still a fugitive at large.

The investigation in this matter was conducted jointly with the U.S. Attorneys Office and the Criminal Investigation Division of the Internal Revenue Service in Portland, Oregon. [U.S. v. George R. Heublein and Gordon H. Flattum, No. CR91-349, D.OR] (LR-13492)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 8, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by New England Mutual Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Insurance Company, New England Variable Life Separate Account (Variable Account) and New England Securities Corporation. The application is for an order of the Commission pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(1), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d) and 27(e) of the Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), (b)(12), (b)(13)(i), (b)(13)(ii), (b)(13)(iii), (b)(13)(iv), (b)(13)(v), (b)(13)(vii), (c)(1) and (c)(4) and 22c-1 and 27e-1 thereunder. The order is sought

in connection with the issuance and sale of variable life insurance policies and would permit the policies to provide for a death benefit that will not always vary based on investment experience, both a contingent deferred sales charge and a sales charge deducted from premiums and a contingent deferred administrative charge. The order would also permit the policies to provide for deduction from the policy's account value for cost of insurance charges, charges for substandard mortality risks and incidental insurance benefits, and a minimum death benefit guarantee charge and values and charges based on the 1980 Commissioners' Standard Ordinary Mortality Tables. In addition, the order would permit the policies to provide for the holding of mutual fund shares funding the Variable Account without the use of a trustee, in an open account arrangement and without a trust indenture. Finally, the order would permit the policies to provide a waiver of notice of refund and withdrawal rights. (Rel. IC-19213 - January 13)

NATIONAL GLOBAL ALLOCATION FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that National Global Allocation Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19210 - January 12)

DREYFUS A BONDS PLUS, INC., ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Dreyfus A Bonds Plus, Inc., et al. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits applicants to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities and to assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares and to waive the CDSC in certain cases. ALLEGRO GROWTH FUND, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Allegro Growth Fund, Inc. under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19215 - January 14)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 8, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by New Orleans Public Service Inc. (NOPSI), a public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to redeem or purchase shares of its new preferred stock to be issued under Rule 52. Additionally, NOPSI requests authority to redeem, at any time prior to December 31, 1994, not to exceed \$135 million of its first mortgage bonds and/or general and refunding mortgage bonds, and not to exceed \$6.5 million aggregate par value of its outstanding preferred stock.
