## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED AGAINST MILO PIKE

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Milo L. Pike (Pike) of Gilford, New Hampshire, ordering him permanently to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, and from committing or causing any future violation of Section 13(d) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13d-2 thereunder. Pike was also ordered to disgorge the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000). In entering the Order the Commission accepted an offer submitted by Pike wherein he neither admitted nor denied the allegations set forth in the Order for Public Administrative Proceedings and consented to the entry of the Order and Findings. Among other things, the Order finds that Pike violated Section 13(d) of the Exchange Act and Rule 13d-2 thereunder, by failing to file timely amendments to his Schedules 13D involving purchases of four issuers. ### SETTLEMENT OFFER OF PAINWEBBER INCORPORATED ACCEPTED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against PaineWebber Incorporated (PaineWebber) and accepting the Offer of Settlement submitted by PaineWebber.

PaineWebber consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. The Order contains findings that PaineWebber failed reasonably to supervise registered representatives employed by PaineWebber at offices in Birmingham, Alabama, Beverly Hills, California, Northbrook, Illinois, Oak Brook, Illinois and Houston, Texas. From November 1986 through June 1988, various registered representatives at the Birmingham, Beverly Hills, Oak Brook and Houston offices engaged in sales practice abuses, including unsuitable and excessive trading, misrepresentations and omissions to state material facts to clients and misappropriation of money from customer accounts. A registered representative at the Birmingham office entered orders for index options without designating the account to which the orders related until after the value of the index options rose or declined and then allocated the profitable trades to his own account or to other participants in the scheme and the losing trades to two customer accounts. From August 1989 through October 1990, a registered representative at the Northbrook office engaged in violations of the registration provisions of the federal securities laws. PaineWebber failed reasonably to supervise the registered representatives with a view toward preventing their violations of the securities laws within the meaning of Section 15(b)(4)(E)(ii) of the Exchange Act.

The Commission's Order censures PaineWebber and requires several undertakings, including a prohibition against opening new accounts for thirty days at the four offices that were involved in the sales practice violations, and the hiring of an independent consultant to review procedures relating to sales of restricted securities and sales practices at PaineWebber. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### ABC INVESTMENT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by ABC Investment Company for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19265 - February 16)

### METLIFE-STATE STREET EQUITY TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by MetLife - State Street Equity Trust, et al. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The conditional order permits applicants to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, and to impose and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. ### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange and the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one issue each which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rels. 34-31862 and 34-31863, respectively)

### WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of PEC Israel Economic Corporation to withdraw from listing and registration its Common Stock, \$1.00 Par Value, on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-31864)

## UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until March 10, 1993 to comment on the applications of three exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 1 issue (Rel. 34-31871); Boston Stock Exchange - 7 issues (Rel. 34-31872); and Pacific Stock Exchange - 14 issues (Rel. 34-31873).

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval of proposed rule change (SR-MSE-93-01) filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange. The MSE proposes to extend its SuperMAX and Enhanced SuperMAX pilot programs for an additional sixty day period. The SuperMAX program guarantees the execution price of small agency market orders received over the Midwest Automated Execution System (MAX) and automatically improves such orders from the consolidated best bid or offer according to certain pre-defined criteria. Publication of the Release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-31857)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-27) by the National Association of Securities Dealers on a permanent basis. The rule change adds a requirement that issuers file notification on a designated form of the issuance of additional shares of securities included in the NASDAQ system and notification of the creation of stock option, employee stock purchase or other stock remuneration plans at least 15 days prior to the creation of such plans. The rule also imposes a fee on issuers to be paid when such issuers notify the NASD of the issuance of an additional amount of an already included security in connection with certain specified transactions. In addition, the NASD will require an issuer in the NASDAQ system to notify the NASD when there is a change in the issuer's transfer agent or registrar.

The Commission previously had approved the rule change, as amended, on a temporary, accelerated basis, until February 28, 1993. (Rel. 34-31859)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
