SEC TO HOST SMALL BUSINESS TOWN HALL MEETING IN LAS VEGAS, NV

The Commission today announced that a small business town hall meeting will be held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 28, 1998, in the Moyer Student Union Ballroom at the University of Nevada at Las Vegas. The small business town hall meetings, which are being conducted throughout the United States, convey basic information to small business about fundamental requirements that must be addressed when these businesses wish to raise capital through the public sale of securities. In addition, the Commission hopes to learn more about the concerns and problems facing small businesses in raising capital so that programs can be designed to meet their needs, consistent with the protection of investors.

Commissioner Norman S. Johnson will be the featured speaker of the Las Vegas Small Business Town Hall Meeting. Other speakers include the Honorable Harry S. Reid, Senator of Nevada, John Scott, Regional Administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration, and Don Reis, Nevada Deputy Secretary of State, among others. A question and answer period will follow the presentations.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION SUSPENDS AND FINES BROKER FOR UNDISCLOSED ARRANGEMENT

The Commission instituted a public administrative and cease and desist proceeding against Paul I. Comi (Comi) pursuant to Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act). Simultaneously with the institution of the proceeding, Comi submitted an Offer of Settlement in which, while neither admitting nor denying the Commission's findings, he consented to the entry of an Order: ordering him to cease and desist from violating Section 15(c)(2) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c2-7 thereunder; suspending him from associating with any broker or dealer for six months; and fining him \$5,000. In the Order, the Commission found, among other things, that Comi, during July and August 1993, while a market maker for the stock of Future Communications, Inc. (FCMI), caused his broker-dealer firm to submit bid quotations for FCMI stock to the NASDAQ system pursuant to an undisclosed profit arrangement with a second broker-dealer firm. Since the second firm also was submitting bid quotations for FCMI stock during the same period, the market was misled as to the true level of demand for FCMI stock. (Rel. 34-39968; File No. 3-9601)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CHARLES KIRBY, GENE GEIGER, ALFRED PEEPER AND EDWARD PRICE

The Commission announced institution of cease and desist proceedings against Charles F. Kirby, chief trader of Spencer Edwards, Inc., Gene C. Geiger, a registered representative at Spencer Edwards, and Alfred Peeper, a customer of Spencer Edwards. Administrative proceedings were also instituted against Spencer Edwards' president Edward H. Price. The Commission's order alleges that Kirby, Geiger, and Peeper violated the registration provisions of the federal securities laws by selling stock of Golden Eagle International, Inc., to the public when no registration statement was filed or in effect. The order further alleges that Price failed to supervise Kirby and Geiger with a view towards preventing the violations.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and, if so, what sanctions, if any, are appropriate and in the public interest, whether a cease and desist order should be issued, and whether disgorgement and civil penalties are appropriate. GOLDEN EAGLE INTERNATIONAL, INC., RONALD KNITTLE, MARY ERICKSON, GREGORY VERNON, TIMBERLINE CONSULTANTS, INC. AND PAUL VERNON NAMED AS DEFENDANTS IN MICROCAP FRAUD COMPLAINT

The Commission announced that on May 7 it filed a complaint in an action involving fraud by Golden Eagle International, Inc., a Denver, Colorado corporation, two of its officers and other defendants. The complaint alleges that the defendants made false public statements concerning mining properties owned or to be acquired by Golden Eagle. The complaint also alleges that the defendants made false filings with the Commission, that Golden Eagle was delinquent in its Commission filings, and that certain of the defendants engaged in an unregistered distribution of Golden Eagle stock.

The Commission's complaint, which seeks injunctive relief, disgorgement and penalties, names as defendants Golden Eagle, Ronald Knittle, its former president, Mary Erickson, a director, and Knittle's wife, Gregory Vernon and Timberline Consultants, Inc., public relations consultants to the company, and Paul Vernon. All the defendants reside in the Denver area. [SEC v. Golden Eagle International, Inc., et al., Civ. Action No. 98-Z-1020, D. Colo.] (LR-15733)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ASSET FREEZE ENTERED AGAINST FIRST AMERICANS BANK LTD., OWEN STEPHENSON, RON SPARKS AND OTHERS

The Commission announced that on May 7 it obtained an emergency restraining order halting the illegal sale of interests in the Native American Free Trade Association "NAFTA", an Oklahoma entity which claims to operate First Americans Bank Ltd. (FAB) on Native American tribal land. The temporary restraining order enjoins Owen K. Stephenson, Ron Sparks, NAFTA, FAB, and two related trust from soliciting additional investor funds and from making false statements. The order in addition freezes the defendants' assets, requires them to account for investor proceeds, and requires the repatriation of assets. The order also freezes the funds of relief defendants First Americans Trust and First Americans Management, which have received investor proceeds.

The Commission's complaint alleged that since early 1997, NAFTA, Sparks and Stephenson have been offering and selling to the public "founding interests" in NAFTA and promising that investors funds would double in two years. NAFTA, Sparks and Stephenson represented that the Apache tribe had authorized FAB to provide private banking services and that FAB was FDIC-insured and operating in Anadarko, Oklahoma. The Commission also alleged that, during 1996, Sparks and Stephenson offered investments in ANB Limited and ANB Trust. Sparks and Stephenson raised at least \$1 million from as many as 100 investors nationwide. According to the complaint, investor proceeds have been commingled, used for personal expenses of NAFTA employees, and in part transferred offshore. In connection with the offerings,

Sparks and Stephenson failed to disclose previous enforcement actions taken against them by federal banking and securities regulatory authorities. [SEC v. First Americans Bank Ltd., et al., Civil Action No. 98-0645, USDC, WD Okla.] (LR-15734)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SAGE LIFE INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by Sage Life Investment Trust (Trust) and Sage Advisors, Inc. (Sage). The Trust and Sage are requesting an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting them from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. The order would provide exemptions to the extent necessary to permit shares of the Trust and all similar investment companies for which Sage may in the future serve as investment manager, investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter or sponsor to be sold to and held by separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA ENERGY GROUP, ET AL.

An order has been issued on a proposal by Columbia Energy Group (CEG) (formerly Columbia Gas System), a registered holding company, and all of its nonutility subsidiaries (Nonutility Subsidiaries). CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries have been authorized to engage in certain consumer-oriented businesses. In addition, CEG and the Nonutility Subsidiaries have been authorized to engage in a broad range of energy-related businesses serving customers inside and outside the United States, either directly or indirectly through newly established or acquired subsidiaries (New Subsidiaries). These businesses would include, but not be limited to, energy management services, energy-related asset management services, technical consulting services, and utility-related consumer services. CEG has been authorized through December 31, 2003 to invest up to \$250 million in these businesses serving customers in the United States and up to \$50 million in these businesses serving customers outside the United States. The Commission has reserved jurisdiction over the proposed sale of goods and services to customers outside the United States, other than energy management and technical consulting services, pending completion of the record. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-98-2) that will add the HUB mailbox service to DTC 's Institutional Delivery system. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39955)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-98-09) to amend Phlx Rule 1101A(a), "Terms of Option Contracts," to revise the strike price intervals for index options. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39964)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-98-17) to list and trade warrants on a narrow-based index. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39965; International Series Rel. 1133)

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-98-12) relating to changes in bond listing procedures and practices. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39973)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-98-16) to change its Order Book Official rate schedule for index options has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39963)

A proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-98-20) to adopt, on a pilot basis, a system enhancement to the X-Station electronic book has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39972)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Pacific Exchange (SR-PCX-97-28) to adopt a policy for the use of Exchange-sponsored floor broker hand-held terminals on the floor of the Exchange. (Rel. 34-39970)
